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PREFACE

Since the release of the provisional result of the last population census conducted in 2006, the general public have been waiting to have access to the detailed information from the exercise. This publication is based on detailed analysis and tables generated from 2006 Population Census and registration of Vital Statistics between 1974 and 2008.

The data contained in the publication are disaggregated by some domains such as sex, age group, etc. The domains are applied wherever relevant. The variables covered include sex, age, literacy, school attendance, educational attainment, disability, marital status, household composition and size.

It is anticipated that this effort to make the data set available will provide the platform for evidence based planning by the state and local governments as also the development partners, the organized private sector, civil society organizations and other stakeholders.

Constructive criticisms are welcome.

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**OBSERVATIONS FROM THE ONDO STATE COMPONENT
OF THE 2006 POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS;
AND VITAL STATISTICS**

(i) **Population and Housing Census**

a. **Population size and Spatial Distribution**

Total population is put at 3,460,877, with males accounting for 50.42% (1,745,057) and females accounting for 49.58% (1,715,820). Population Density is 255.00. Annual population growth rate is high at 2.87% and about 53% of women are in age group 15-49, the reproductive age group. The effect is high population momentum that will be felt in the coming years and will result in continued high population growth (Tables 2,3 and 4).

b. **Age Structure**

The age structure of the population in the State is young with 38% of the population being in bracket (0-14).The elderly population of 65 years and above constitutes 3.7%. As a result of this, the Age Dependency Ratio is still high at 72 persons per 100 population (Tables3, 4 and 5).

c. **Educational Attainment**

Data on Educational Attainment reveals that 559,480 or 19.3% have passed SSS or equivalent, 208223 or 7.12%OND/NCE, 145915 or 4.99% University Graduates/HND and about 25592 or 0.88% post graduates in the State. About 3732 or 0.13% have other qualifications. Other educational attainment figures shows 14.74% Nursery, 14.51% Primary, 15.98%JSS/Morden School and 22.52% have no educational attainment (Table 6).

d. **Literacy**

There is a net absolute increase of the literate population by about931,545 since the 1991 census. However, the absolute number of Illiterates has increased by 110,966

The overall literacy rate has improved from 72.3% in 1991 to 78% in 2006 census. Male literacy improved from 78% in 1991 to 81% in 2006, while that of the female improved from 67% to 76%. The gender gap in literacy has narrowed down significantly (Tables 7 and 8).

e. Marital Status

The population that fall into marital status age group comprise of 50.10% Never married, 46.49% Married, 0.96% Separated, 0.70% Divorced and 1.75% Widowed (Table 9).

f. Disability

The total number of 'Disabled' persons of both sexes is 56,941 or 1.65% comprising of 28,953 males and 27,988 female. The "Disability rate for males is slightly higher at 1.7% while for females, it was 1.6% (Table 13).

Out of the 6 Types of Disability captured in the 2006 census, about 26.95% of the 'Disabled' population reported seeing Disability, 17.79% reported Hearing, 23.15% reported speaking, 16.17% reported Mobility, 5.23% reported mental while 10.71% reported other type of Disability. Comparative analysis of Disability population shows that absolute disabled population increase from 224,954 in 1991 to 346,087 in 2006 (Table 14).

g. Schooling

A total of 314,765 representing about 88% of Children in age group 6-9 are reportedly attending School (Table 15).

h. Housing

Out of a total 774,574 households, 98.51% are regular households, 1.13% Institutional/Census functionaries, 0.07% Homeless Households, 0.07% Homeless Person, 0.11% Nomadic Households, 0.06% Transient Person/Household, 0.06% Fishing and hunting person/Household (Table 16)

i. Water and Sanitation

Tables 17, 18 and 19 reveal the water and sanitation situation in the State in 2006. Table 17 shows that about 44% depended on Dug wells, 30 % on River/Stream/Spring, 9% in Boreholes, 5% on Pipe Borne Water and the rest 12 % on other sources.

J. Lighting and Fuel

The distribution of household by type of main lighting/Fuel shows that about 64% use Electricity, 33% use Kerosene, 2% use Candle while the rest use other types.

(ii) Vital Statistics

The data on Vita Statistics in this report covers the period 1994-2008. Highlights discernable from the report include the following indicators:

a. Registered live birth by year of registration:

The birth registration coverage between 2000-2007 ranges between 14% and 35%

A total of 129,877 live births were recorded for the period 1994-2007. The number of male live birth was slightly higher at 52.1% while female was 47.9%.

The registration trend show low level of registration recorded in 1994 with gradual increase over the years (Table 25). Age group (25-29) of mothers recorded the highest number of live births (Table 26).

The report shows that higher percentage of registration took place in the urban area (70.3%) than in rural area (29.6%). Of the total live births registered in the state, 76.1% took place in the Hospital/Maternity homes while 14.01% took place at home 0.76% of the registered births took in Traditional Doctors' place while 9.12% took place in other places (Tables 30 and 31).

Data on registered deaths by sex shows that of the total death registered for the period, 70.93% % were males and 29.07% were females (Table 32).

23.9% of the death registered were attributed to fever and 14.0% to accidents/Injuries. Other causes of death include other ailments (11.65%), Serility (11.48%), HIV/AIDS (8.9.2%), Disorder of Blood air system (8.75%), child birth and Pregnancy comp (5.91%). Disorder of resp (5.48%), Digestive Disorder (4.97%), Disorder of centralnervous system (4.37%) and Disorder of Urinary tracts (0.51%).

Figure of Registered live birth by Local Government area indicates that Akure South recorded the highest number of registered live births (18.58%) while the lowest was recorded in Ondo East (2.36%) (Table 40).

The general apathy in deaths registration is noticed in the data for registered death. The scanty data shows that 47.32% registered deaths occurred in Akure South. There was no record for three Local Governments; Ifedore, Ondo East and Ose (Table 40).

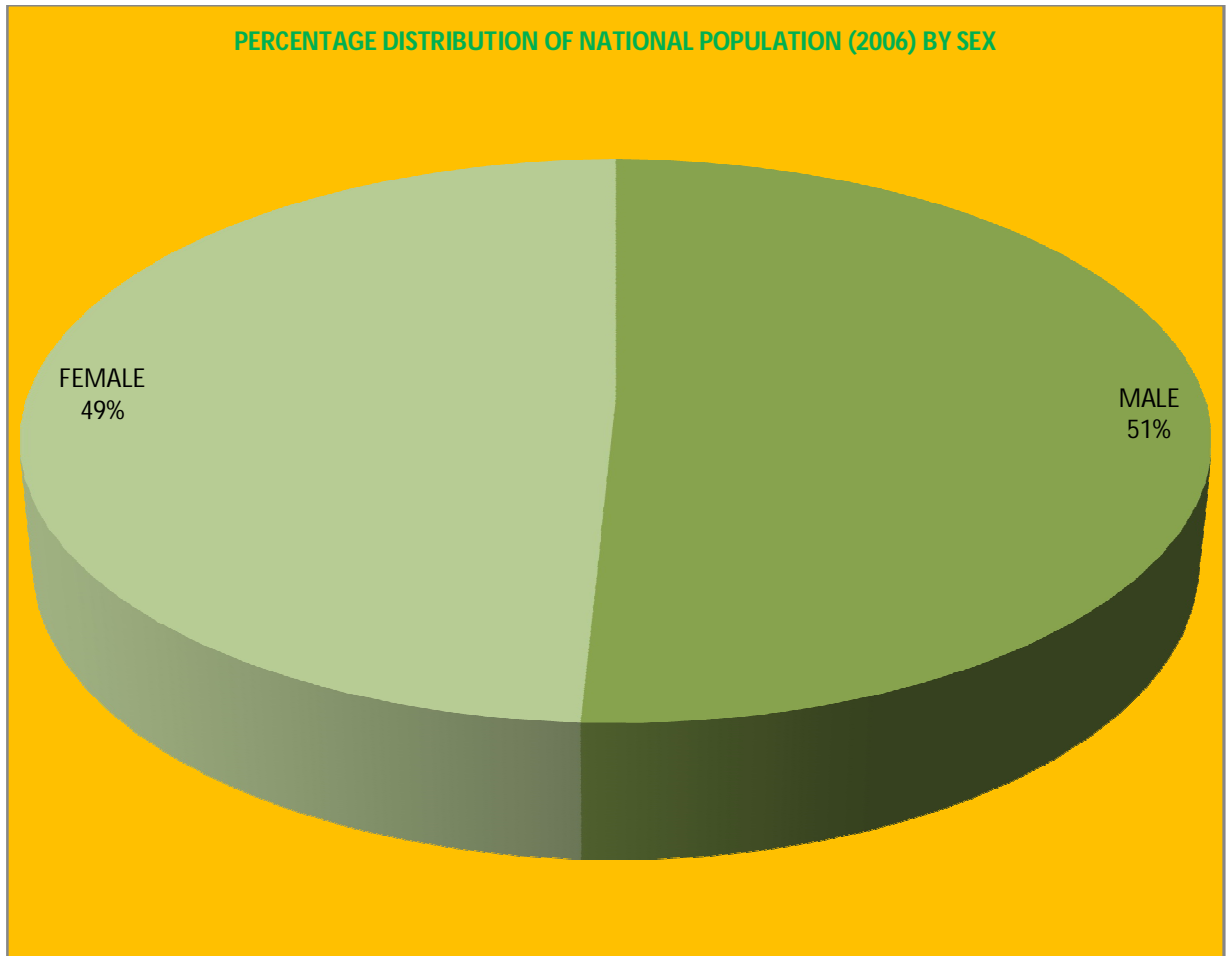

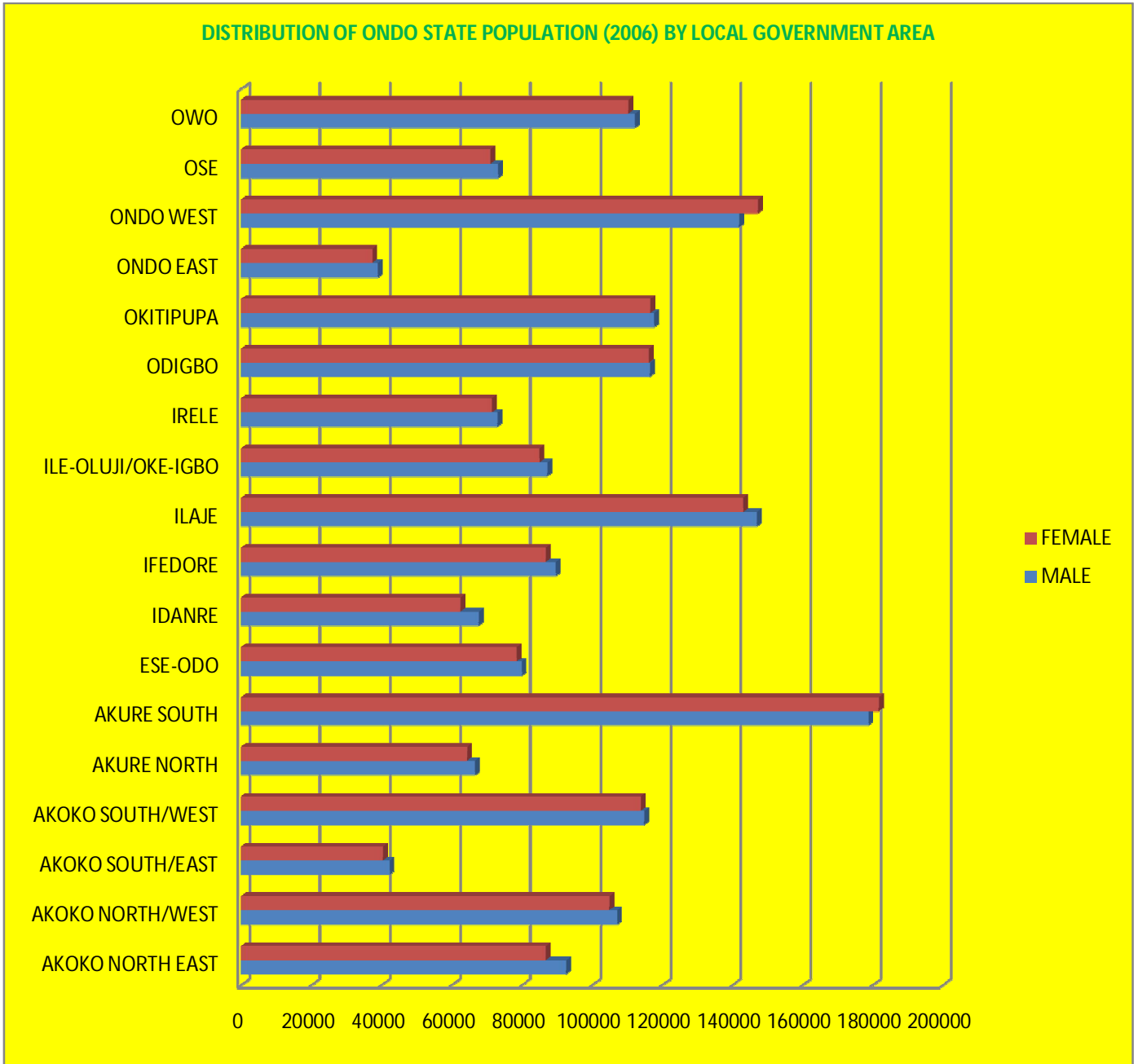

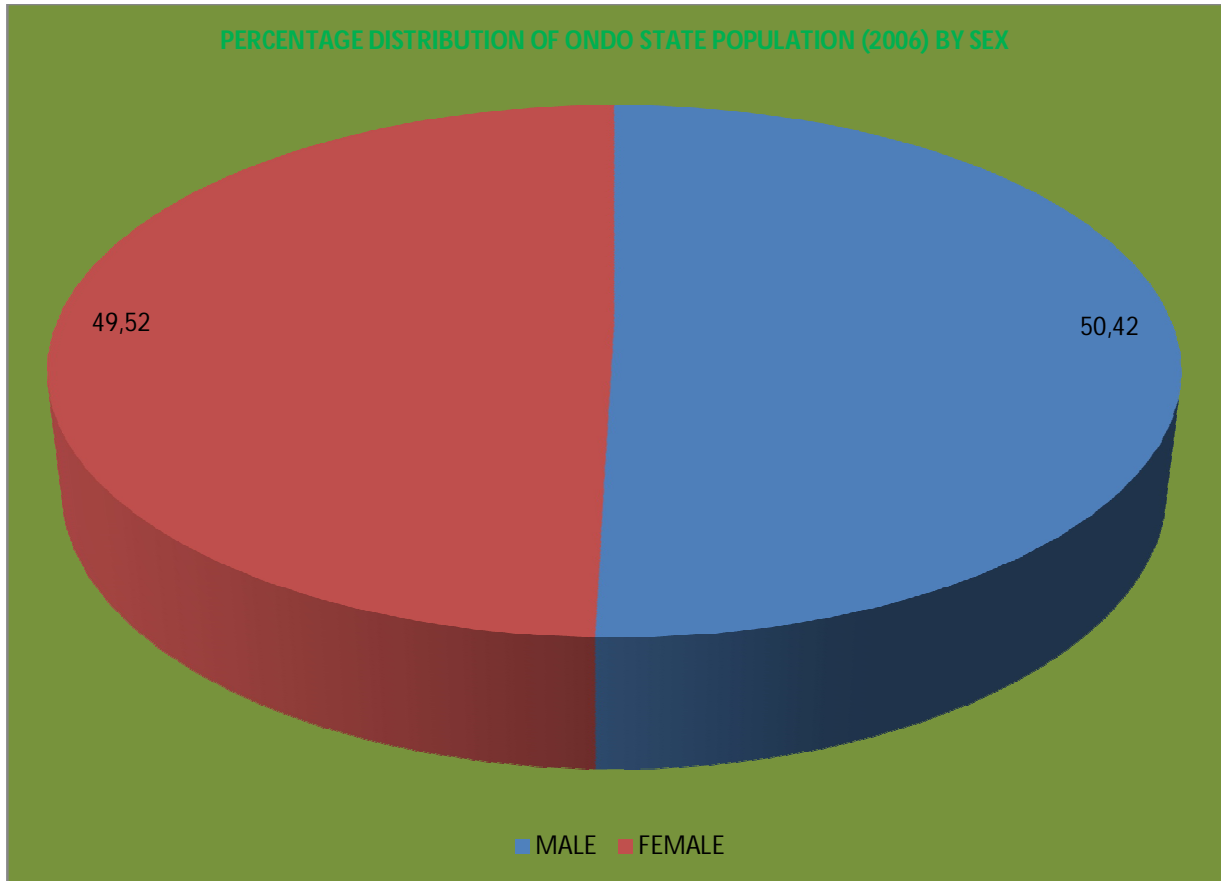

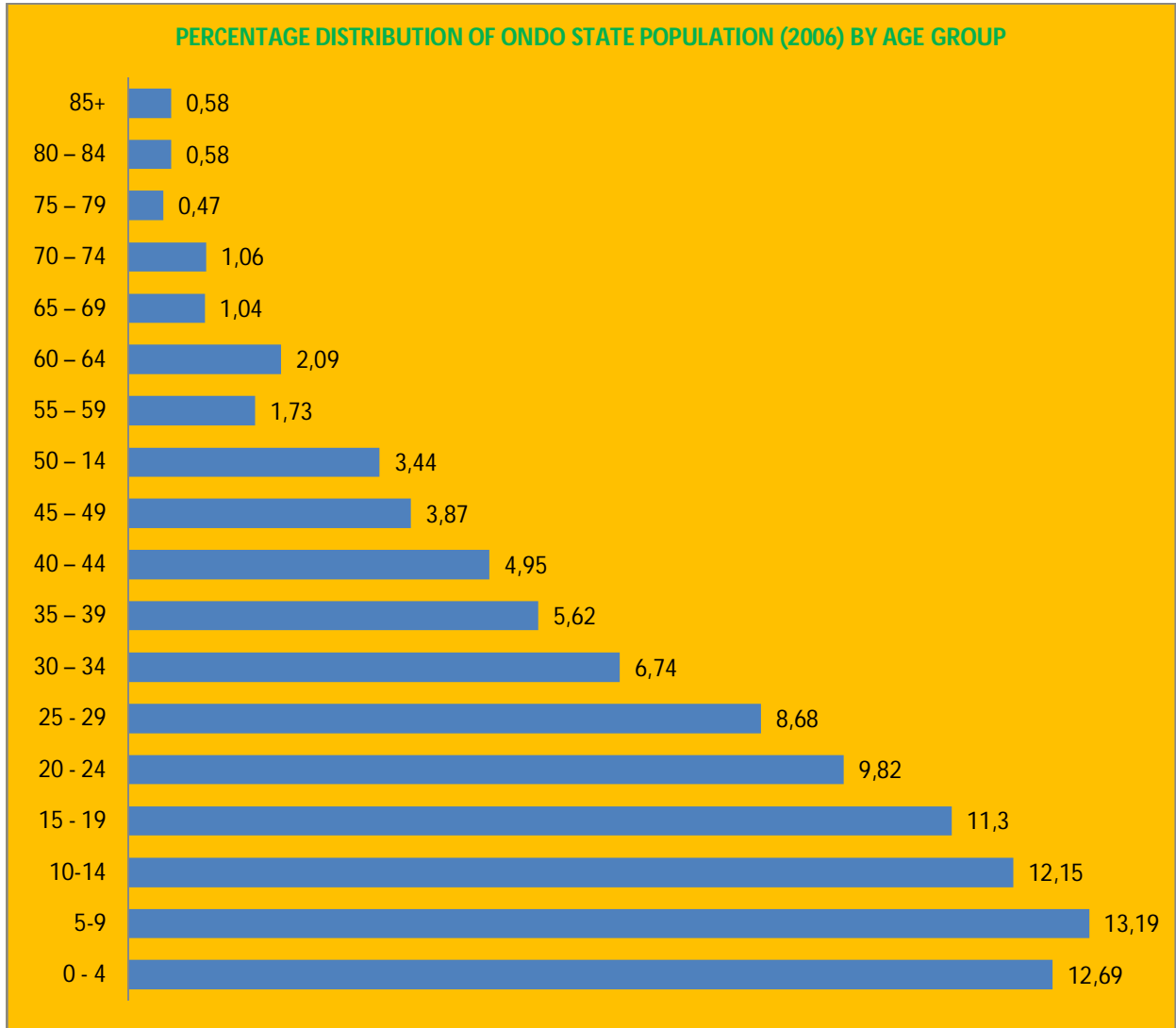

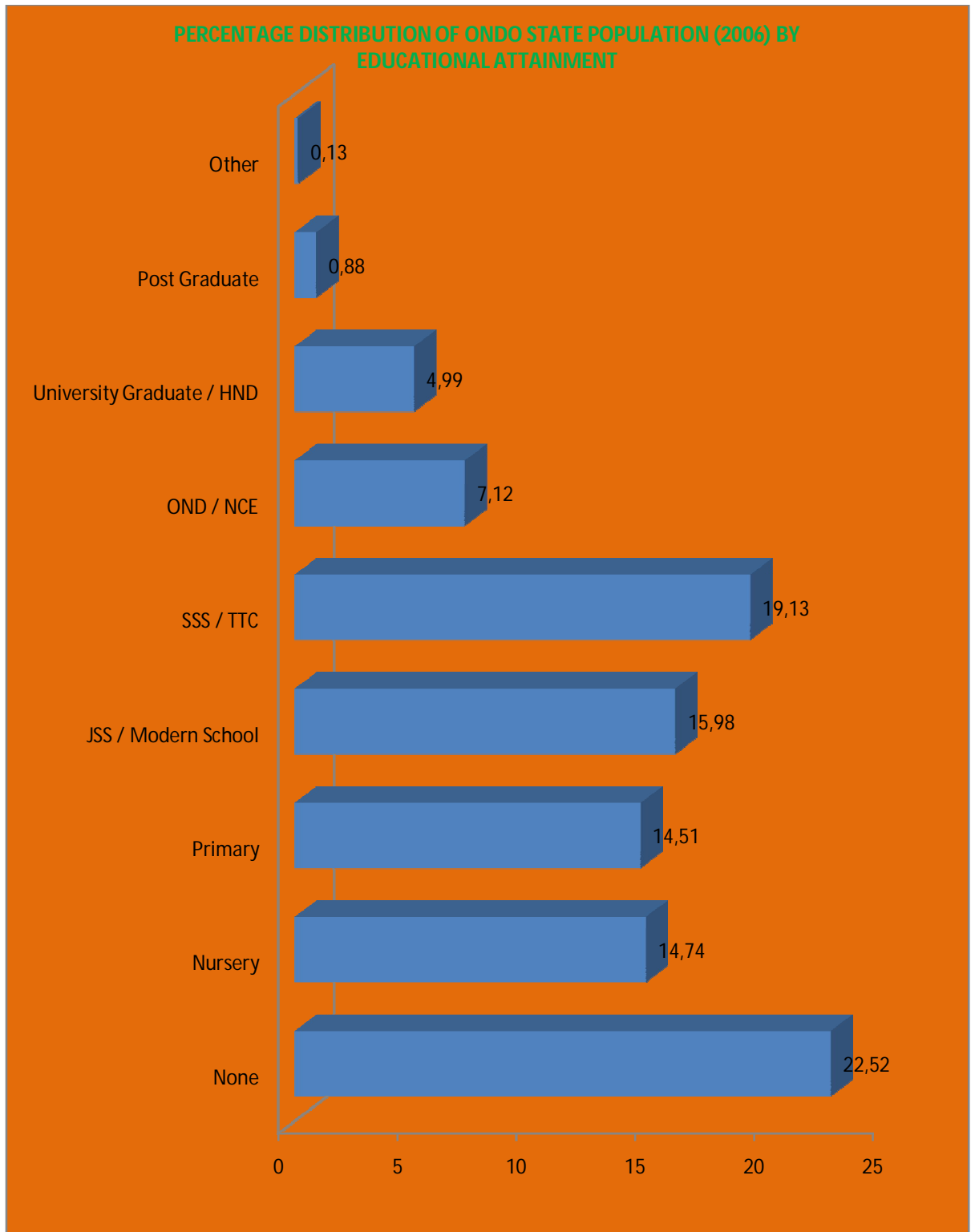

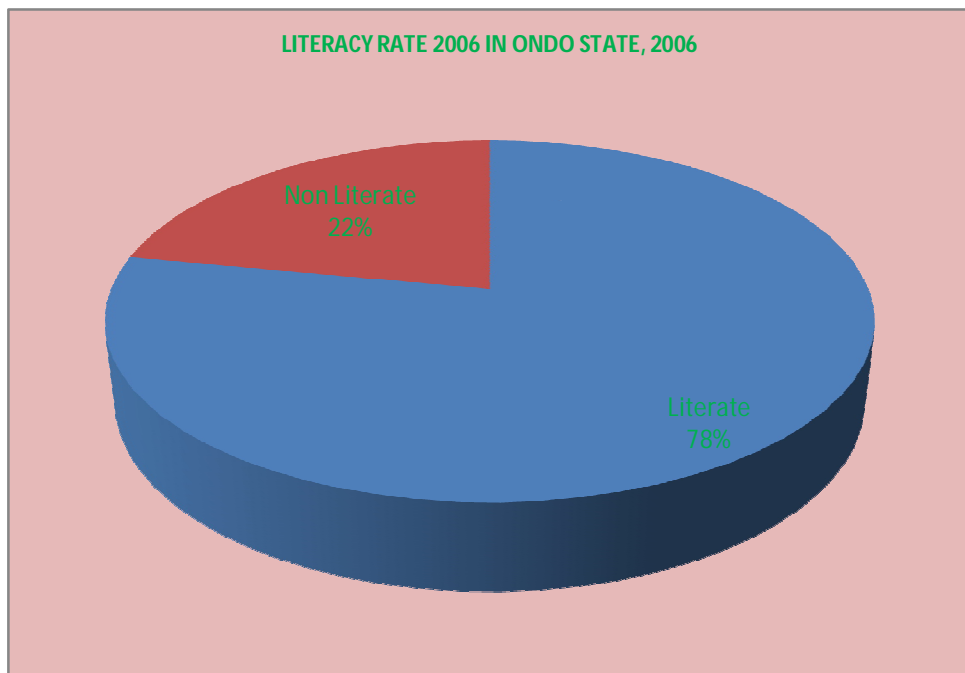

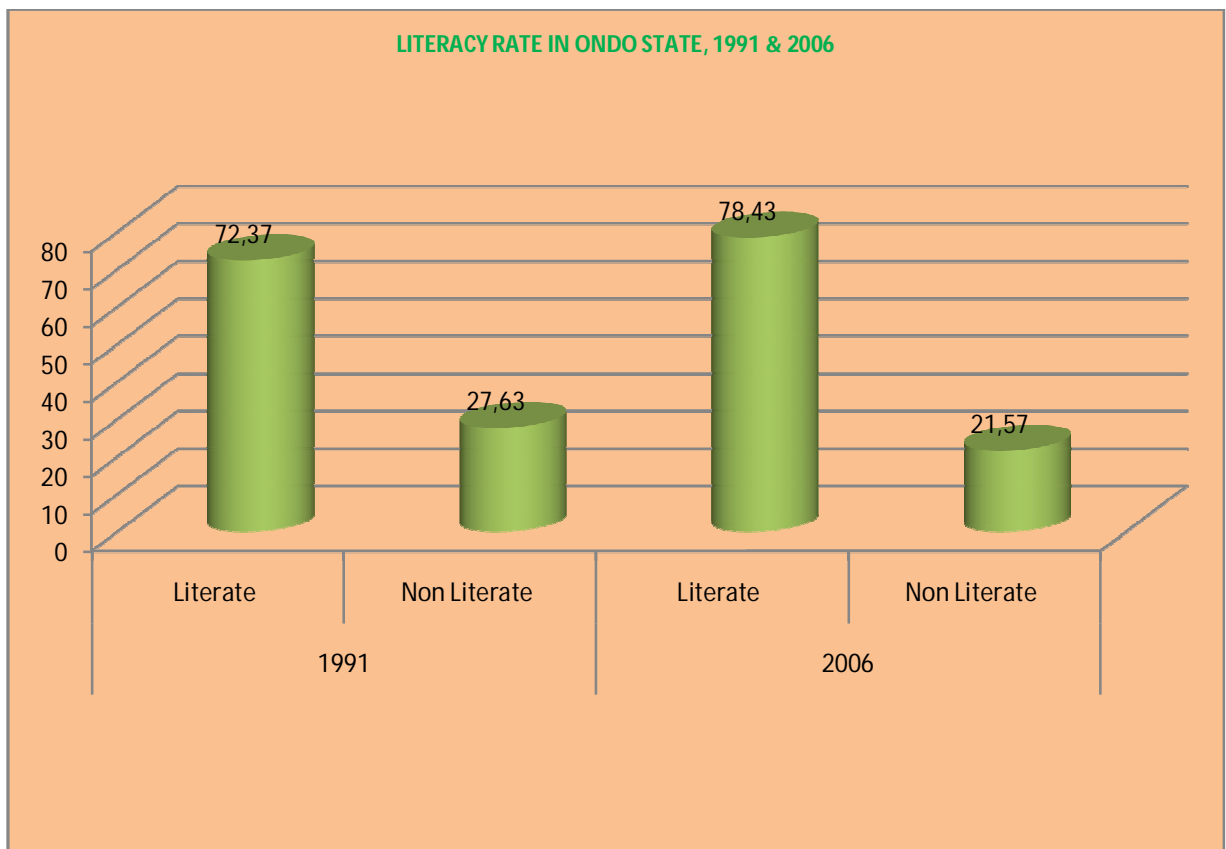

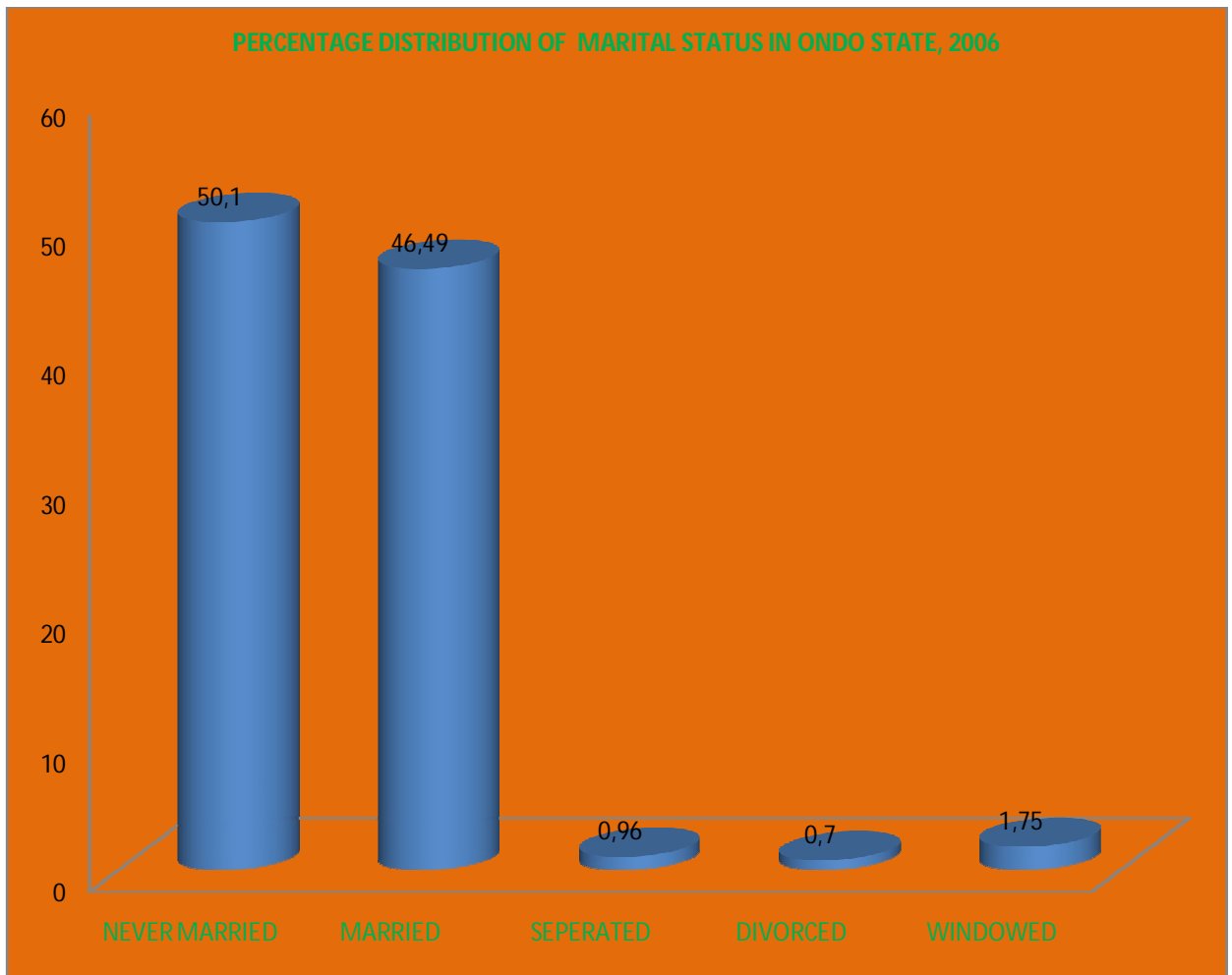

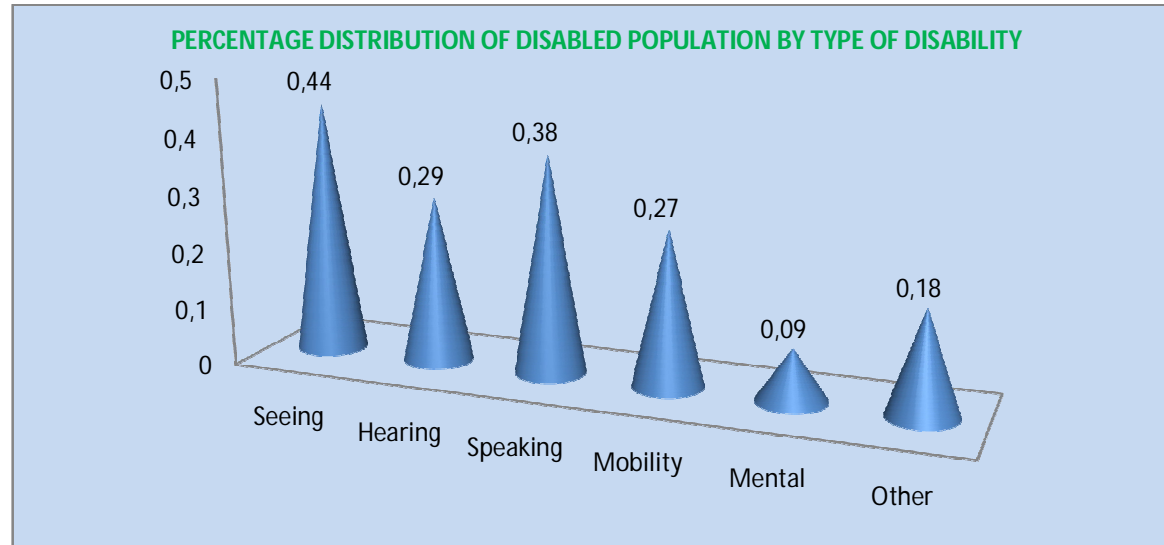

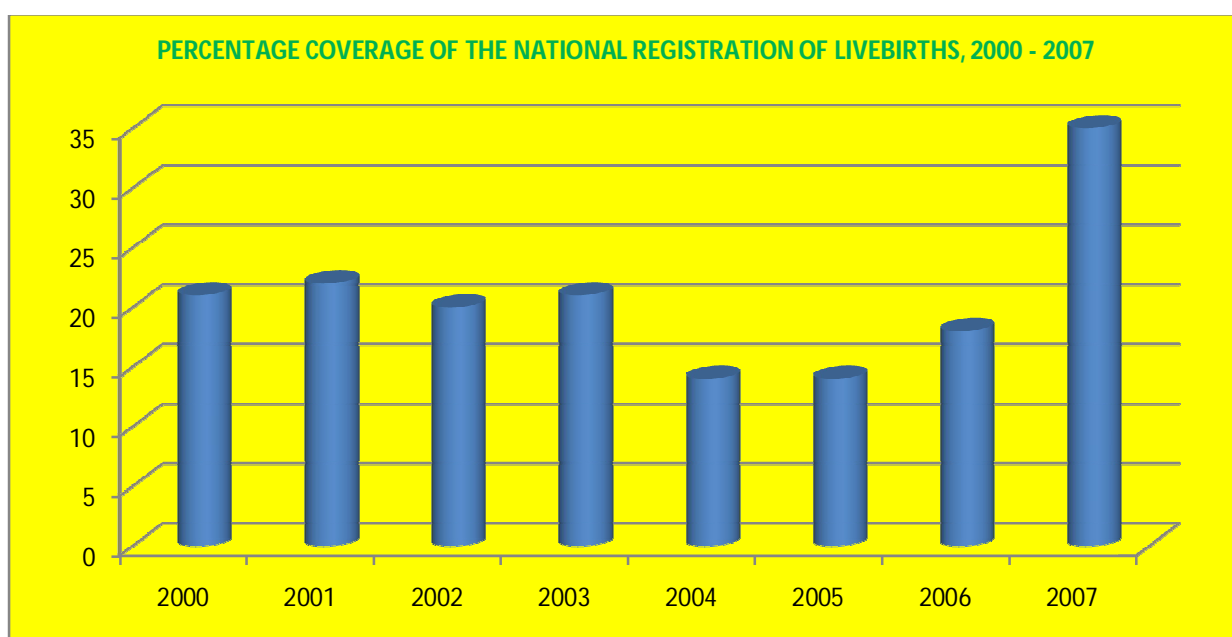

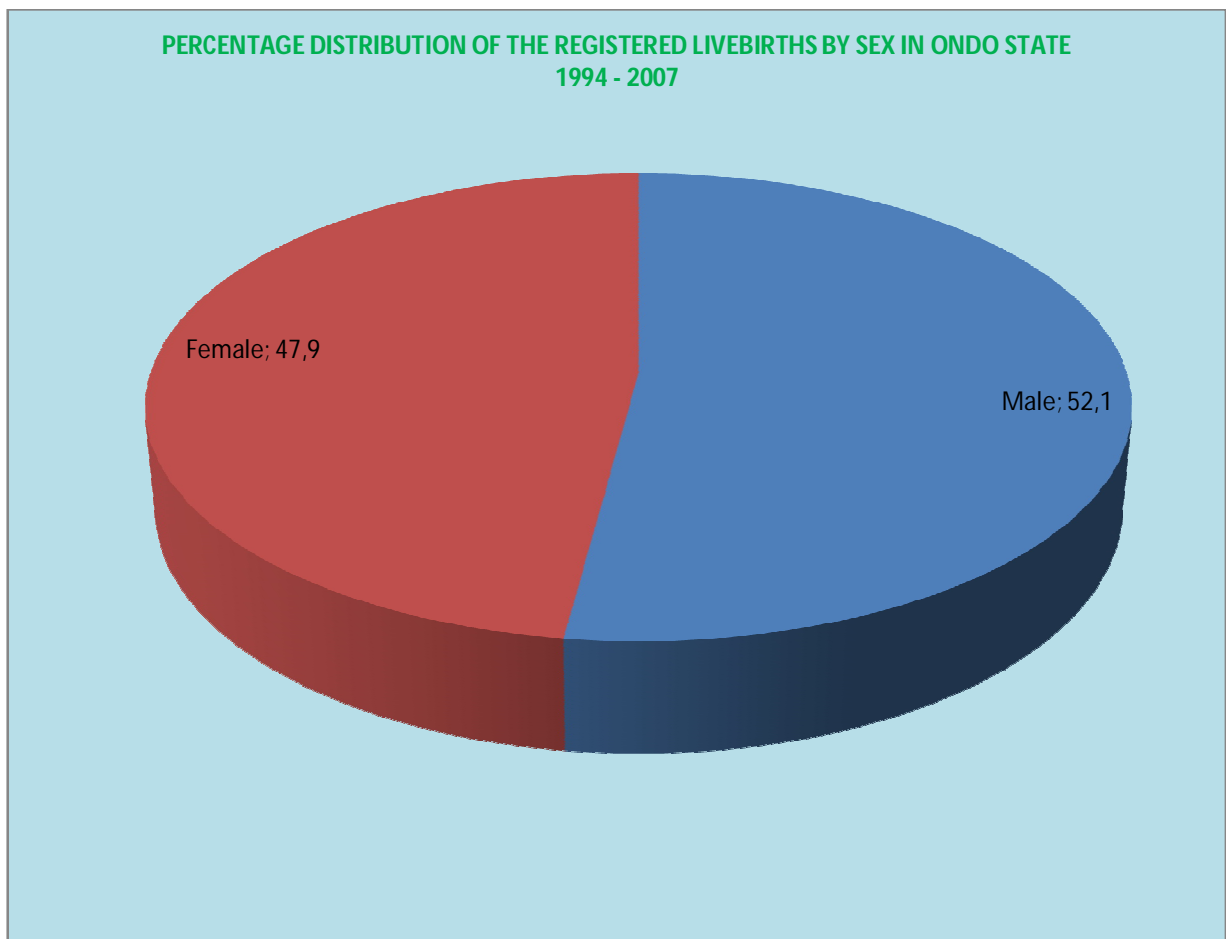

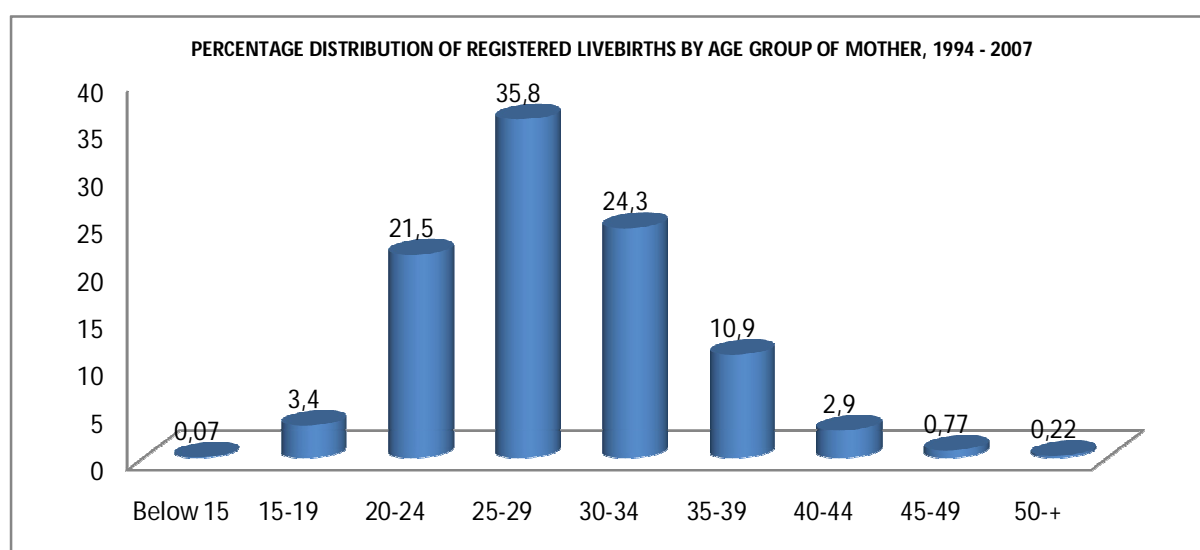

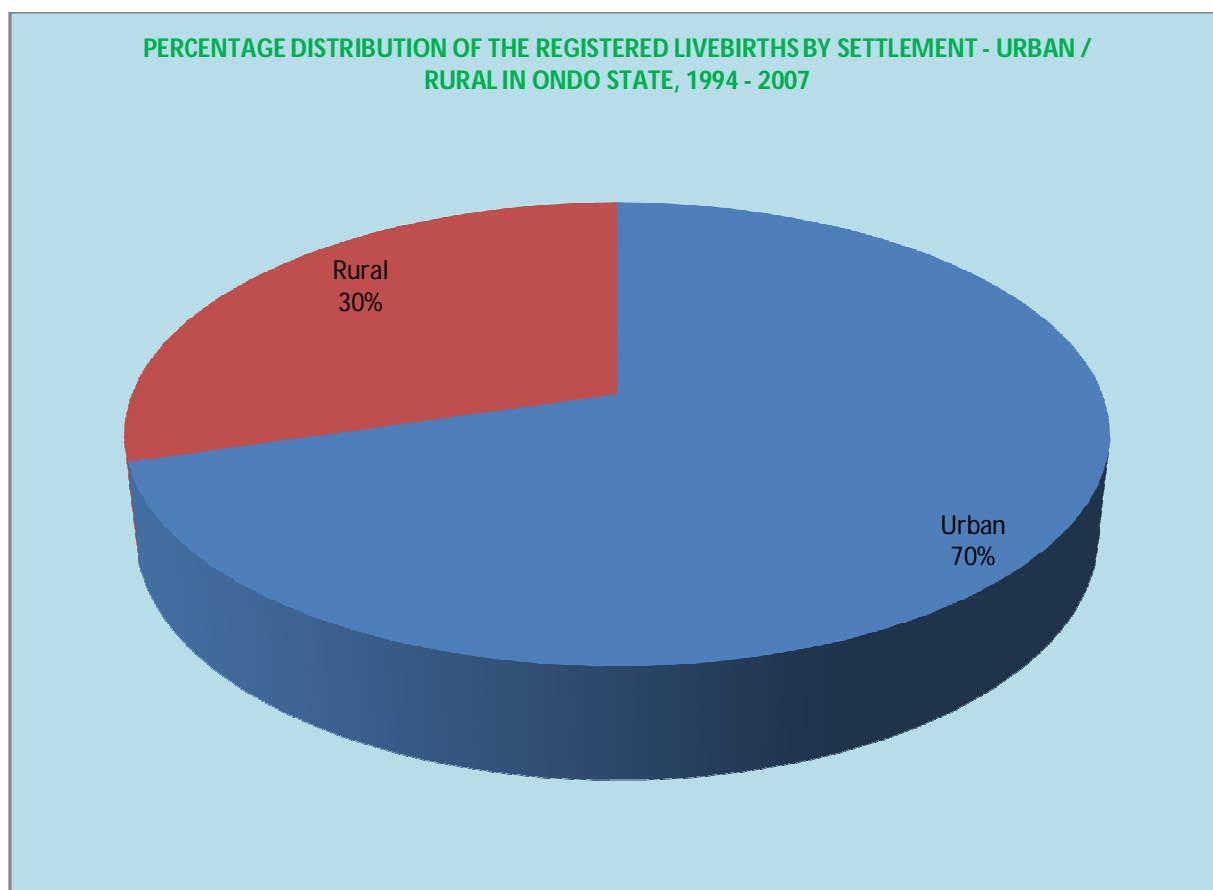

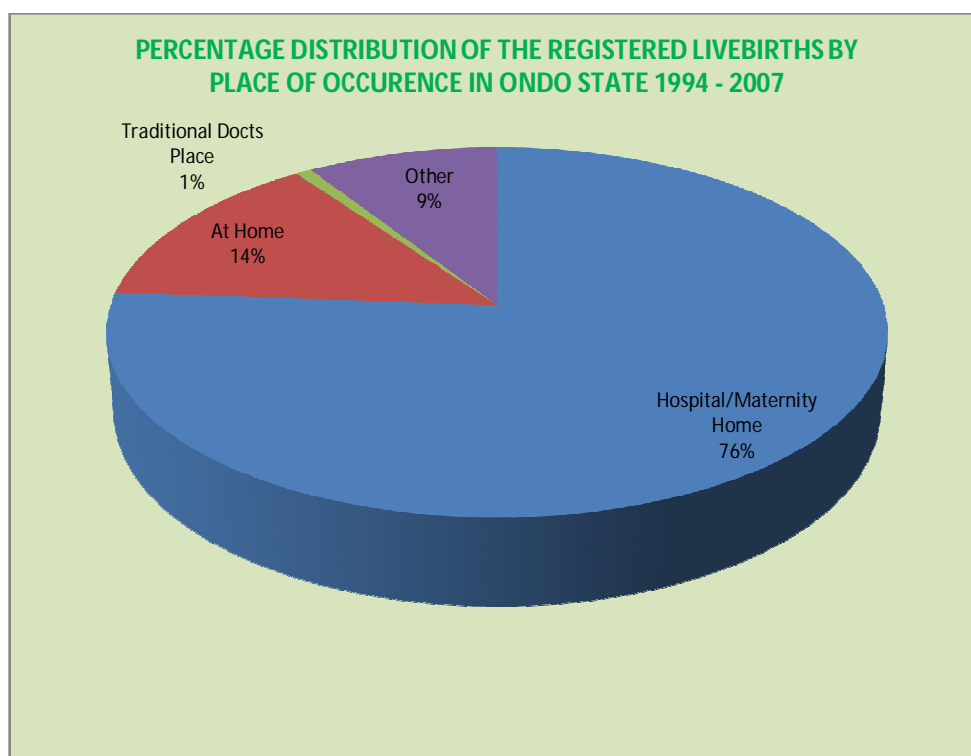

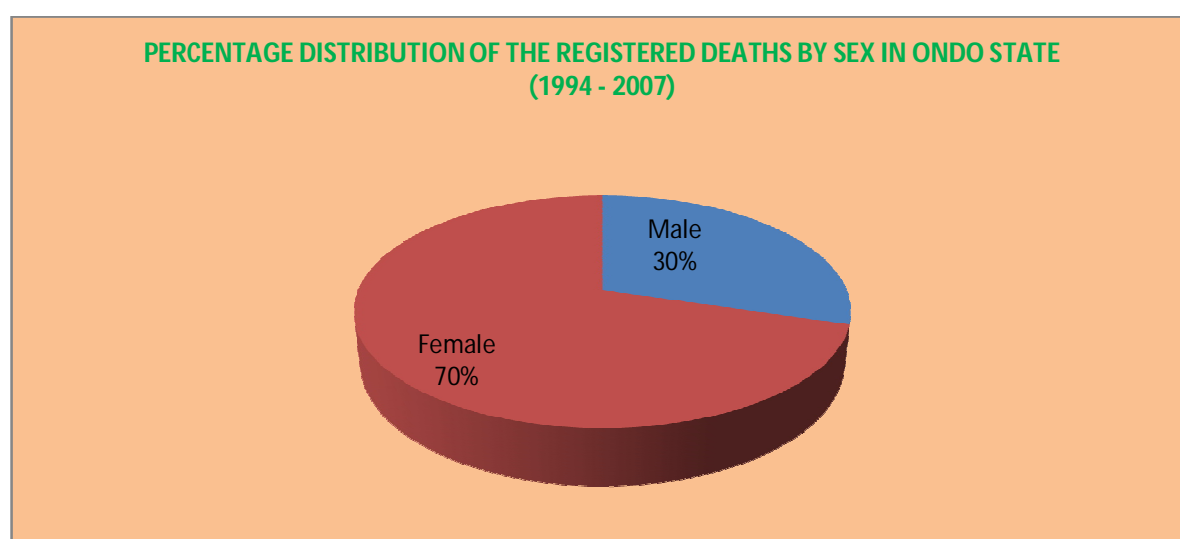

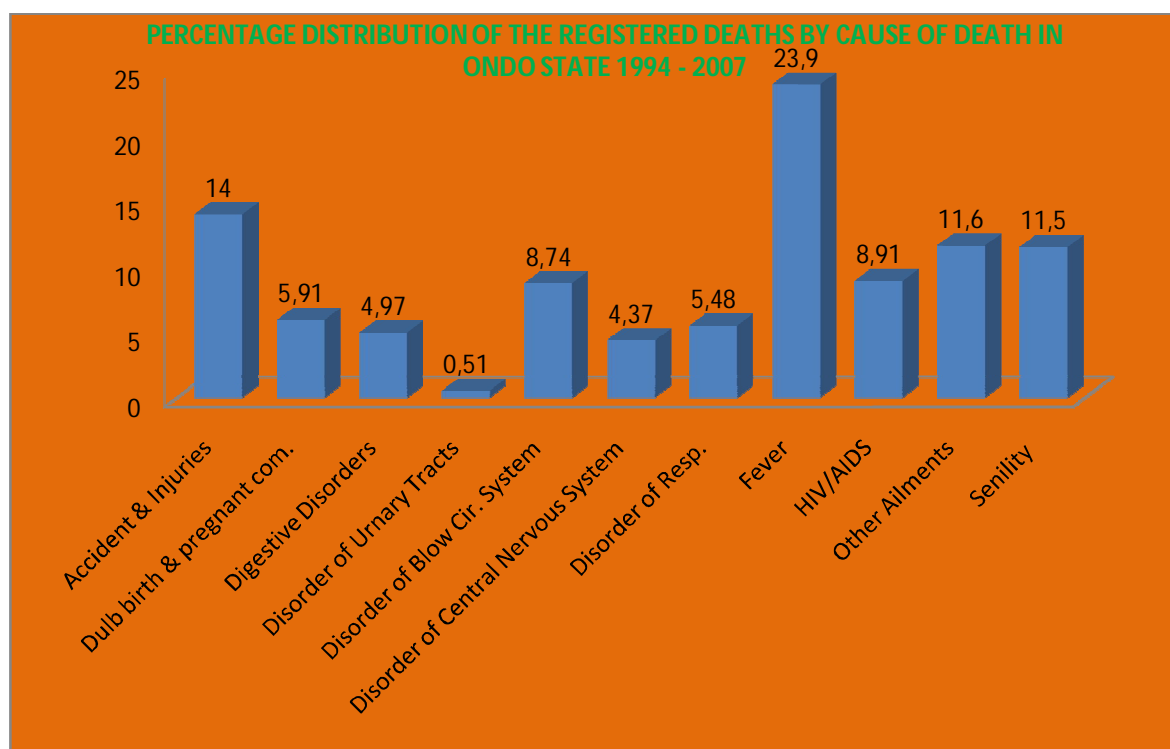
