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Preface

This publication provides data on Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) estimates for the four quarters of 2020, the annual figure for 2020, the four quarters of 2021, and the annual figure for 2021.

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are integrated system of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation on a quarterly basis. They provide a picture of the current economic status of the economy that is timelier and more frequent than that provided by Annual National Accounts (ANA). The key attribute of QNA is that they provide a reasonable level of detail of the economy that help government to assess, analyse, and monitor economic growth on a regular basis.

QNA adopts the same concepts, definitions and structure as ANA. In principle QNA covers the entire sequence of accounts and balance sheets as reflected in the 2008 System of National Accounts (2008 SNA).

Data for this analysis were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS). This series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP by kind of economic activities at current and constant (2010) prices.

We are grateful to the various agencies and establishments that made their data available as input to the estimates.

Introduction

The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) has been conducting Establishment Surveys to provide data for the estimation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the country. In 2008, NBS started to improve the GDP series by conducting Quarterly Establishment Surveys (QES) for the four quarters of each year to provide timely estimates for decision and policy making.

In 2018, the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) conducted the Quarterly Establishment Surveys for the first three quarters of 2018 (Q1-Q3/ 2018), while the fourth quarter survey for 2018, the first, second and third quarter survey for 2019 were conducted in 2019. Moreover, the fourth quarter survey for 2019, the first, second and third quarter survey of 2020 were conducted in 2020. Similarly, the fourth quarter survey for 2020, the first, second and third quarter survey for 2021 were conducted in 2021. Nevertheless, the fourth quarter survey for 2021 was conducted this year. These surveys produced the data that were used for the compilation of the quarterly GDP for the four quarters of 2018(Q1 – Q4, 2018), the four quarters of 2019 (Q1 – Q4, 2019), the four quarters of 2020(Q1-Q4, 2020) and the four quarters of 2021 (Q1-Q4, 2021).

In subsequent sections of this report, emphasis will be given to the composition of GDP in the fourth quarter of 2021 and the annual for 2021. The Bureau will also be looking at the corresponding quarter of 2020 and the immediate past quarter of 2021 (Q3 2021).



Overview of GDP in Quarter Four 2021

Nigeria's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) grew by 3.98%(year-on-year) in real terms in the fourth quarter of 2021, showing a sustained positive growth for the fifth quarter since the recession witnessed in 2020 when output contracted by -6.10% and -3.62% in Q2 and Q3 of 2020 under the Covid pandemic. The fourth quarter growth indicates a steady economic recovery accounting for an annual growth of 3.40% in 2021. The Q4 2021 growth rate was higher than the 0.11% growth rate recorded in Q4 2020 by 3.87% points and lower than 4.03% recorded in Q3 2021 by 0.05% points. Nevertheless, quarter on quarter, real GDP grew at 9.63% in Q4 2021 compared to Q3 2021, reflecting a higher economic activity than the preceding quarter.

In the quarter under review, aggregate GDP stood at N49,276,018.23 million in nominal terms. This performance is higher when compared to the fourth quarter of 2020 which recorded aggregate GDP of N43,564,006.29 million, indicating a year-on-year nominal growth rate of 13.11%. The nominal GDP growth rate in Q4 2021 was higher relative to 10.07% growth recorded in the fourth quarter of 2020 but lower compared to 15.41% growth recorded in the preceding quarter. 2021 annual nominal growth stood at 13.92%. For better clarity, the Nigerian economy has been classified broadly into the oil and non-oil sectors.




Figure 1: Real GDP Growth





The Oil Sector

The nation in the fourth quarter of 2021 recorded an average daily oil production of 1.50 million barrels per day (mbpd), lower than the daily average production of 1.56mbpd recorded in the same quarter of 2020 by 0.06mbpd and lower than the third quarter 2021 production volume of 1.57mbpd by 0.07mbpd. (Figure2).




Figure 2: Crude Oil Output (MBPD)

Real growth of the oil sector was -8.06% (year-on-year) in Q4 2021 indicating an increase by 11.71% points relative to rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2020. Growth increased by 2.68% points when compared to Q3 2021 which was -10.73% . Quarter-on-Quarter, the oil sector recorded a growth rate of -24.06% in Q4 2021. Annual growth stood at -8.30% , a rate better than the -8.89% recorded in 2020. The Oil sector contributed 5.19% to total real GDP in Q4 2021, down from figures recorded in the corresponding period of 2020 and down compared to the preceding quarter, where it contributed 5.87% and 7.49% respectively. Nevertheless, the sector contributed 7.24% to real GDP in 2021.

The Non-Oil Sector

The non-oil sector grew by 4.73% in real terms during the reference quarter (Q4 2021). This rate was higher by 3.05% point compared to the rate recorded same quarter of 2020 and 0.71% point lower than the third quarter of 2021. This sector was driven in fourth quarter 2021 mainly by Agriculture (crop production); trade; Information and Communication (Telecommunication); and Financial and Insurance (Financial Institutions), accounting for positive GDP growth. In real terms, the Non-Oil sector contributed 94.81% to the nation's GDP in fourth quarter 2021, higher from share recorded in the fourth quarter of 2020 which was 94.13% and higher than the third quarter of 2021 recorded as 92.51%. The annual contribution in 2021 was 92.76%.





Figure 3: Crude Oil and Non-Oil Growth

CONTRIBUTION OF OIL AND NON-OIL SECTORS








CONTRIBUTION TO REAL GDP Q4 2021 (%)

Major Economic Sectors: Q4 2021

Mining & Quarrying

The Mining & Quarrying sector consists of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas, Coal Mining, Metal ore and Quarrying and other Minerals sub-activities. This sector grew nominally by 8.65% (year on year) in Q4 2021. Quarrying and Other Minerals exhibited the highest growth rate of all the sub-activities at 88.44%, followed by Coal Mining activity at 79.86%. However, Crude Petroleum and Natural gas was the main contributor to the sector with a weight of 77.12% in Q4 2021. Comparing Q4 2021's rate of growth against the Q4 2020 and Q3 2021 growth rates, there was a rise of 20.97% points and a rise of 13.30% points respectively. The Mining & Quarrying sector contributed 5.25% to overall GDP in the fourth quarter of 2021, lower than the contributions recorded in 2020 fourth quarter at 5.46% and lower than the previous quarter recorded at 6.32%. Annual contribution of the sector to nominal GDP stood at 6.19%.

In real terms, the Mining and Quarrying sector grew by -6.16% (year-on-year) in the fourth quarter of 2021. Compared to the same quarter of 2020 and third quarter 2021, it was higher by 12.28% points and higher by 4.40% points respectively. Quarter on quarter, growth rate recorded was -21.33%, while annual growth stood at -7.79% in 2021. The contribution of Mining and Quarrying to Real GDP in the quarter under review stood at 5.50%, lower than the rate of 6.09% recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2020 and lower than the 7.66% recorded in the third quarter of 2021 respectively.




Figure 4: Mining and Quarrying real growth

Agriculture

Four sub-activities make up the Agricultural sector: Crop Production, Livestock, Forestry and Fishing. The sector grew by 12.86% year-on-year in nominal terms in Q4 2021, showing a fall of 1.17% points from the same quarter of 2020. Looking at the preceding quarter's growth rate of 7.95%, there was an increase of 4.92% points. Crop Production remained the major driver of the sector. This is evident as it accounts for 91.23% of overall nominal growth of the sector in fourth quarter 2021.

Quarter on Quarter growth stood at -0.65% in fourth quarter 2021, while annual growth was at 10.43% in 2021. Agriculture contributed 24.17% to nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2021. This figure was lower than the rate recorded for the fourth quarter of 2020 and lower than the third quarter of 2021 which recorded 24.23% and 26.57% respectively.




Figure 5: Agriculture real growth

The agricultural sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 grew by 3.58% (year-on-year) in real terms, an increase of 0.16% points from the corresponding period of 2020, and an increase of 2.36% points from the preceding quarter which recorded a growth rate of 1.22%. It grew on a quarter-on-quarter basis at -1.69%. Nonetheless, an annual growth of 2.13% was recorded in 2021.

However, the sector contributed 26.84% to overall GDP in real terms in Q4 2021, lower than the contribution in the fourth quarter of 2020 and lower than the third quarter of 2021 which stood at 26.95% and 29.94% respectively.

Manufacturing

The Manufacturing sector is comprised of thirteen activities: Oil Refining; Cement; Food, Beverages and Tobacco; Textile, Apparel, and Footwear; Wood and Wood products; Pulp Paper and Paper products; Chemical and Pharmaceutical products; Non-metallic Products, Plastic and Rubber products; Electrical and Electronic; Basic Metal and Iron and Steel; Motor Vehicles and Assembly; and Other Manufacturing.

Nominal GDP growth of the Manufacturing sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 was recorded at 25.52% (year-on-year), 0.92% points higher than figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2020 (24.60%) and 7.21% points lower than the preceding quarter figure of 32.73%. Quarter on Quarter growth of the sector was recorded at 0.03%, while annual growth of 31.66% was recorded in 2021. The contribution of Manufacturing to Nominal GDP in fourth quarter 2021 was 14.28%, higher than figure recorded in the corresponding period of 2020 at 12.87% and lower than the third quarter of 2021 at 15.59%.

Real GDP growth in the manufacturing sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 was 2.28% (year on year), higher than the same quarter of 2020 and lower than the preceding quarter by 3.80% points and 2.01% points respectively. Growth rate of the sector on a quarter-on-quarter basis stood at 3.57%. Real contribution to GDP in 2021 fourth quarter was 8.46%, lower than the 8.60% recorded in fourth quarter of 2020 and lower than the 8.96% recorded in third quarter 2021.




Figure 6: Manufacturing real growth

Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply

The Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air conditioning Supply sector recorded a year-on-year growth of 18.12% in the fourth quarter of 2021. This was 0.85 percentage points higher than the 17.27% growth rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2020, and 25.03 percentage points lower than the growth rate of 43.14% recorded in the quarter before. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector recorded a growth rate of 30.26% in Q4 2021, while annual growth of 51.83% was recorded in 2021. The contribution of Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply to Nominal GDP in fourth quarter 2021 was 1.02%, higher than the contribution made in the corresponding quarter of 2020 at 0.98% and higher with its contribution of 0.86% in the quarter before. Annual share of the sector stood at 1.00% in 2021.

In real terms, the sector grew by 2.78% in Q4 2021, an improvement from the growth rate of -2.51% recorded in the same quarter of 2020. When compared to the immediate past quarter, there was a decrease of 11.58 percentage points from 14.36% recorded. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew at a rate of 30.19%, while annual growth stood at 27.57% in 2021. The contribution of this sector to real GDP in fourth quarter 2021 was 0.47%, lower than 0.48% recorded in Q4 2020. This figure in 2021 was higher than 0.40% recorded in Q3 2021. Annual contribution stood at 0.47% in 2021.




Figure 7: Elect. Gas and Steam real growth

Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation

This sector grew by 50.73% in nominal terms (year on year) in 2021 fourth quarter, a rise by 25.22% points compared to the rate of 25.51% recorded in the same quarter of 2020. There was an increase of 11.60% points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter on quarter was recorded at -4.84%, while annual growth was 44.28% in 2021. Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation sector contributed 0.23% to nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2021, higher than the 0.17% it contributed a year earlier and lower than the 0.27% contributed in the third quarter of 2021.

The real growth rate of the Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 was recorded at 28.84% (year on year), higher by 26.92% points from the rate recorded a year previous. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was an increase of 15.87% points. Quarter on quarter, the sector grew by -4.91% in real terms, while annual growth of 18.34% was recorded in 2021.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 0.16% in the fourth quarter 2021; higher from its contribution of 0.13% in the same quarter of the previous year, and lower than in the immediate past quarter where it contributed 0.18%.




Figure 8: Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation real growth

Construction

The Construction sector grew by 34.53% in nominal terms (year on year) in 2021 fourth quarter, a drop of 9.05% points compared to the rate of 43.58% recorded in the same quarter of 2020. There was a decrease of 13.14% points when compared to the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Nominal growth quarter on quarter was recorded at 17.86%, while 2021 recorded 42.50% growth rate. Construction contributed 9.99% to nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2021, higher than the 8.40% it contributed a year earlier and higher than the 9.26% contributed in the third quarter of 2021. Annual contribution of the sector stood at 9.56% in 2021.

The real growth rate of the construction sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 was recorded at 3.46% (year on year), higher by 2.24% points from the rate recorded a year previous. Relative to the preceding quarter, there was a decrease of 0.64% points. Quarter on quarter, the sector grew by 17.82% in real terms, with an annual growth rate of 3.09 in 2021.

Its contribution to total real GDP was 3.46% in the fourth quarter 2021; lower from its contribution of 3.47% in the same quarter of the previous year, and higher than in the immediate past quarter where it contributed 3.22%. 2021 share of the sector in GDP stood at 3.49%.

Trade

In the fourth quarter of 2021, the nominal year on year growth rate of Trade stood at 6.01%. This indicates an increase of 6.67% points when compared to the fourth quarter of 2020 growth rate of -0.66% and 8.83% points lower than the previous quarter growth rate of 14.84%. The quarter-on-quarter growth rate was 13.51%, while annual growth stood at 10.34% in 2021. Trade's contribution to Nominal GDP in the fourth quarter of 2021 was 13.25%, lower than the contribution in the same quarter of the previous year of 14.13%, and higher than the preceding quarter recorded at 12.75%. However, the sector contributed 13.42% in 2021.




Figure 10: Trade real growth

In real terms, Trade's year-on-year growth stood at 5.34% in fourth quarter 2021, which was 8.54% points higher than the rate recorded one year previous at -3.20%, and 6.56% points lower than in the preceding quarter at 11.90% growth rate. Quarter on quarter growth stood at 15.00%. This growth was higher than the quarter-on-quarter growth recorded in the third quarter of 2021 at -0.41%. Annual growth rate was 8.62% in 2021. Trade's contribution to GDP was 15.66%, higher than the 15.46% it represented in the previous year, and higher than the 14.93% recorded in 2021 third quarter.

Accommodation and Food Services

In nominal terms, Accommodation and Food Services grew by 1.66% year-on-year in 2021 fourth quarter. This represents an increase of 2.45% points relative to the same quarter of 2020, when the growth rate was -0.79%. Growth was lower than the preceding quarter by 17.54% points when growth was 19.20%. Quarter on quarter growth stood at 11.77%, while annual growth was 11.13% in 2021. Accommodation and Food Services contribution to nominal GDP stood at 0.88% in fourth quarter 2021, lower slightly than the figure recorded a year previous and higher than third quarter 2021 contribution recorded at 0.97% and 0.86% respectively. It contributed 0.86% to annual GDP in 2021.

The real year-on-year growth rate for this sector in 2021 fourth quarter stood at 1.27%, higher by 16.30% points from -15.03% recorded a year previous. Relative to the preceding quarter, growth rate was 0.82% points lower from 2.09% recorded. Quarter on quarter real growth was 25.06%, while annual growth stood at -0.45% in 2021. The sector in fourth quarter of 2021 represented 0.78% of the real GDP, which is lower slightly with the contribution of 0.80% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2020 and higher than the third quarter 2021 contribution of 0.69%. In 2021, 0.72% was contributed by the sector.

Transportation and Storage

Six activities make up the Transportation and Storage sector: Road Transport; Rail Transport and Pipelines; Water Transport; Air Transport; Transport Services; and Post and Courier Services.

The sector grew by 23.14% in nominal terms in the fourth quarter of 2021 (year on year). This rate was higher relative to the figure of -3.76% recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2020 and lower than 41.61% in the previous quarter. All the six sub-activities under Transport and Storage industry recorded positive growth rates in the fourth quarter 2021. Quarter on Quarter growth stood at 40.00%, while annual growth was 27.95% in 2021. Transport activities contributed 2.01% to Nominal GDP in Q4 2021, an increase from the 1.84% recorded in the corresponding period of 2020, and higher than 1.57% recorded in third quarter of 2021.

In real terms, the Transportation and Storage sector grew by 29.72% in Q4 2021. This rate represents an increase of 35.67% points relative to the same quarter of the previous year and an increase of 9.12% points relative to the preceding quarter. Quarter on Quarter, growth was 86.43%, while annual growth rate was 16.25% in 2021. The contribution of the sector to real GDP in the Q4 2021 totaled 1.65%, a rise from 1.32% recorded a year previous and higher than 0.97% recorded in the third quarter of 2021.

Information & Communication

The Information and Communication sector is composed of the four activities of Telecommunications and Information Services; Publishing; Motion Picture, Sound Recording and Music Production; and Broadcasting.

In nominal terms, in the fourth quarter of 2021 the sector growth was recorded at 5.70% (year-on-year), 10.62% points decrease from the rate of 16.32% recorded in the same quarter of 2020, and 5.47% points lower than rate recorded in the preceding quarter. The Quarter-on-Quarter growth rate recorded in fourth quarter 2021 was 17.10%, while annual growth stood at 5.75% in 2021. The Information and Communications sector contributed 9.88% to total Nominal GDP in the 2021 fourth quarter, lower than the rate of 10.58% recorded in the same quarter of 2020 and higher than the 9.22% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

The sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 recorded a growth rate of 5.03% in real terms, year on year. From the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2020, there was a decrease of 9.92% points. Quarter on Quarter, the sector exhibited a growth of 17.43% in real terms, while annual growth stood at 6.55% in 2021. Of total real GDP, the sector contributed 15.21% in 2021 fourth quarter, higher than in the same quarter of the previous year in which it represented 15.06% and higher than the preceding quarter in which it represented 14.20%.




Figure 11: Info and Communication real growth

Arts, Entertainment and Recreation

In Nominal terms, the growth of Arts, Entertainment and Recreation sector was 4.94% in fourth quarter 2021 (year-on-year), representing an increase of 0.57% points relative to the preceding quarter growth rate of 4.37% and an increase of 5.81% points compared with the year earlier growth rate of -0.87%. On a quarterly basis, growth was recorded at 17.65%, higher than quarter-on-quarter growth of Q3 2021 recorded at -3.87%. Annual growth stood at 2.39% in 2021. The activity contributed 0.14% to total nominal GDP in fourth quarter 2021. This contribution was lower than the 0.15% it contributed in Q4 2020 and higher with the 0.13% it contributed in Q3 of 2021.

In real terms, the activity grew by 4.31% year-on-year which was more than the rate recorded in Q4 2020 by 5.83% points, and more by 0.63% points when compared with that of the preceding quarter. Quarter on Quarter, growth stood at 17.52% in real terms, while annual growth was 1.72% in 2021. Overall, Art, Entertainment and Recreation contributed 0.20% to real GDP in Q4 2021, relatively same with the 0.20% recorded one year previous and higher than 0.18% recorded in the third quarter of 2021.

Real Estate Services

In nominal terms, Real Estate Services in the fourth quarter of 2021 grew by 3.48%, lower by 5.67% points than the growth rate reported for the same period in 2020 and lower by 5.15% points compared to the preceding Quarter. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector growth rate was 21.31%, while annual growth was 6.59% in 2021. The contribution to nominal GDP in Q4 2021 stood at 5.85% as against 6.40% recorded in fourth quarter of 2020 and higher than the 5.27% accounted in third quarter of 2021. Annual contribution of the sector was 5.33% in 2021.

Real GDP growth recorded in the sector for fourth quarter 2021 stood at 1.47%, lower than the growth recorded in fourth quarter of 2020 by 1.34% points, and lower by 0.85% points relative to Q3 2021. Quarter-on-quarter, the sector grew by 24.41% in the fourth quarter 2021, while annual growth was 2.26% in 2021. It contributed 6.23% to real GDP in Q4 2021, lower than the 6.38% it recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2020.

Finance and Insurance

The Finance and Insurance Sector consists of the two subsectors, Financial Institutions and Insurance, which accounted for 92.18% and 7.82% of the sector respectively in real terms in Q4 2021.

As a whole the sector grew at 24.92% in nominal terms (year-on-year), with the growth rate of Financial Institutions as 25.99% and 13.61% growth rate recorded for Insurance. The overall rate was higher than that in Q4 2020 by 26.02% points, and lower by 1.54% points than the preceding quarter. Quarter on Quarter growth was 25.34%, while annual growth rate stood at 11.88% in 2021. The sector's contribution to the overall nominal GDP was 3.10% in Q4 2021, higher than the 2.80% it represented a year previous, and higher from the contribution of 2.70% it made in the preceding quarter.

Growth in this sector in real terms totaled 24.14%, higher by 27.76% points from the rate recorded in 2020 fourth quarter and up by 0.90% points from the rate recorded in the preceding quarter. Quarter on Quarter growth in real terms stood at 26.99%, while annual growth was 10.07% in 2021. The contribution of Finance and Insurance to real GDP totaled 3.66%, higher than the contribution of 3.07% recorded in the fourth quarter of 2020 by 0.59% points, and higher than 3.16% recorded in Q3 2021 by 0.50% points.




Figure 12: Finance and Insurance real growth

Professional, Scientific and Technical Services

In fourth quarter 2021, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services recorded a nominal growth of 2.15% (year-on-year), which is 5.10% points higher than Q4 2020, and 1.62% points lower than the rate recorded in Q3 2021. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by 12.44%, while annual growth was 1.67% in 2021. The contribution of Professional, Scientific and Technical Services to nominal GDP was 2.84% in Q4 2021, down from the 3.14% contribution in Q4 2020 and up from the 2.76% recorded in Q3 2021. The sector contributed 2.77% to GDP in 2021.

Real growth in the sector was recorded at 1.50% in Q4 2021, an increase of 6.94% points relative to the rate recorded in the corresponding period of 2020, and 0.39% points higher than that of Q3 2021. On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the sector grew by 13.92% in Q4 2021, while annual growth was 0.05% in 2021. Professional, Scientific and Technical Services contributed 3.35% to aggregate GDP in Q4 2021, lower than the 3.44% it contributed in Q4 2020 and higher than 3.23% recorded in Q3 2021.

Administrative and Support Services

In nominal terms, the Administrative and Support Services sector grew by 3.35% (year-on-year) in Q4 2021, higher by 6.18% points compared to fourth quarter, 2020 and lower by 2.72% points than the growth rate in the previous quarter. Quarter on Quarter, growth rate in the sector was -6.02% in Q4 2021, while annual growth stood at 4.24% in 2021. The contribution of Administrative and Support Services to nominal GDP was 0.02% in Q4 2021, relatively same from the 0.02% it contributed in the same period in 2020 and the 0.02% it contributed in the preceding quarter.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 2.70% (year-on-year), an increase of 8.01% points from the corresponding quarter of 2020 and a decrease of 0.66% point from the rate recorded in Q3 2021. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by -4.78% in Q4 2021, while annual growth was 2.57% in 2021. The sector's contribution to real GDP was 0.02% in 2021 fourth quarter, roughly unchanged from the corresponding quarter in 2020 and 2021 third quarter.

Public Administration

In nominal terms, the Public Administration sector grew by 1.77% in Q4 2021, lower by 2.70% points from the corresponding quarter of 2020 and lower by 0.70% points relative to Q3 2021. Quarter-on-Quarter, the sector grew by 14.30%, while annual growth was 1.22% in 2021. The contribution of Public Administration to Nominal GDP stood at 1.83% in Q4 2021, lower than the 2.04% recorded in Q4 2020 by 0.20% points and higher than the 1.75% recorded in Q3 2021 by 0.08% points. Annual contribution in 2021 stood at 1.73%.

In real terms, the sector recorded a growth rate of 1.13% (year on year) in Q4 2021, lower by 0.67% points and higher by 1.28% points from the Q4 2020 rate and the Q3 2021 rate respectively. On Quarter on Quarter, the sector grew by 15.80% in Q4 2021, while annual growth rate stood at -0.30%. The contribution of Public Administration to Real GDP stood at 2.17% in Q4 2021, lower compared to 2.23% in Q4 2020 and higher from 2.05% in Q3 2021. The sector contributed 2.03% to real GDP in 2021.

Education

Nominal growth in the Education sector in the fourth quarter of 2021 was 1.93% (year-on-year), up by 7.79% points from the growth of -5.86% reported in the corresponding quarter of 2020, and down by 5.82% points when compared to Q3 2021 growth rate of 7.75%. Quarter-on-Quarter growth rate was 32.31%, while annual growth stood at 3.60% in 2021. The contribution of Education to nominal GDP in Q4 2021 was 1.86%; down from 2.06% estimated in Q4 2020 and up from 1.54% in Q3 2021.

Real growth in Education year-on-year stood at 1.42% in Q4 2021; an increase of 12.86% points from the corresponding quarter of 2020 which was estimated at -11.43%. When compared with the previous quarter's rate of 1.37%, the sector's growth increased by 0.05% points. The Education sector grew by -0.75% in 2021. The Sector contributed 2.13% to total real GDP in Q4 2021 which was lower than 2.18% reported for corresponding Quarter in 2020 and higher than the 1.69% recorded in Q3 2021. However, annual contribution of the sector stood at 1.80% in 2021.

Human Health and Social Services

The year-on-year growth rate for Human Health and Social Services in nominal terms was 5.69%, down relative to the growth rate of 9.14% reported in the same quarter of 2020 by 3.45% points and down by 5.51% points compared to Q3 2021. Quarter on Quarter growth was 0.39%, while annual growth stood at 9.63% in 2021. The contribution to nominal GDP was 0.55% in Q4 2021, lower than the 0.58% recorded in Q4 2020 and down from the 0.59% recorded in Q3 2021. Annual contribution in 2021 was recorded at 0.60%.

Real GDP growth of Human Health and Social Services for Q4 2021 stood at 5.14% (year-on-year) compared to 3.05% for the corresponding period of 2020 which shows a rise of 2.09% points. The growth in Q4 2021 was also higher than the growth recorded in Q3 2021 by 0.15% points. Quarter-on-Quarter, this sector grew by 4.26%, while annual growth stood at 4.93% in 2021. The contribution of Human Health and Social Services to real GDP was 0.66% in Q4 2021, relatively higher from the figure recorded in Q4 2020 and down from the 0.69% recorded for the preceding quarter. Annual contribution of the sector to real GDP stood at 0.70% in 2021.

Other Services

In nominal terms, Other Services grew by 2.28% (year-on-year) in Q4 2021. This growth rate was higher than the -1.76% growth rate recorded in the same quarter of the previous year and lower than the growth rate of 3.37% in Q3 2021 by 4.04% points and 1.10% points respectively. Quarter on Quarter growth was 56.74%, while annual growth stood at 1.46% in 2021. This sector contributed 2.86% to the aggregate nominal GDP in Q4 2021, lower than the 3.17% it contributed in the same period of the previous year and higher than 2.00% it contributed in the preceding quarter. Annual contribution to nominal GDP in 2021 stood at 2.67%.

Other Services real GDP grew by 1.63% (year-on-year) in Q4 2021. This growth was higher by 5.90% points than the growth recorded in the same period of the previous year, and higher by 0.90% points from Q3 2021. Quarter on Quarter growth was 58.80%, while annual growth rate was -0.16% in 2021. The sector contributed 3.39% to real GDP in Q4 2021 against the 3.46% recorded for the corresponding quarter of 2020 and the 2.34% recorded in Q3 2021.

Methodological Notes

Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) are an integrated system of macroeconomic accounts designed to describe the entire system of production in a nation on a quarterly basis. They provide a picture of the current economic status of an economy on a more frequent basis than Annual National Accounts (ANA). In providing a reasonable level of detailed information of the economy, QNA allows the government to regularly assess, analyze and monitor economic developments.

In line with international standards outlined under the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSTATS), four major methodological pillars underpin GDP compilation in Nigeria:

The System of National Accounts (SNA 2008 version)

The internationally agreed standard of recommendations as to how to compile measures of economic activity.

The International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC Revision 4.0):

This is the international reference for the classification of productive activities. Its main purpose is to provide a set of activity categories that can be used for the collection and reporting of statistics according to such activities.

The Central Product Classification (CPC version 2)

A classification based on the physical characteristics of goods or on the nature of services rendered. The CPC covers products that are output of economic activities.

Data for this analysis were obtained from the Quarterly Establishment Survey (QES) conducted by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS), tax receipts from the Federal Inland Revenue Service, and other administrative sources such as the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation. The series covers major aggregates of quarterly GDP under 46 activities at current and constant (2010) prices.

Using the above data and standards, GDP is computed as gross output minus intermediate consumption. Both gross output and intermediate consumption are detailed below for each activity:

1. AGRICULTURE

Under Section A, Division 01-03 of ISIC rev 4, Agriculture is divided into four main activities.

1.1 CROP PRODUCTION

Section A, Division 01 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Quantities produced multiplied by farm gate price, less losses (wastages).

Intermediate consumption: Seeds, fertilizer, pesticides, hire of farm implements and simple farm tools that are used up in one farming season.

1.2 LIVESTOCK PRODUCTION

Section A, Division 01 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output is calculated using the following Live animals and their produce + imports = animals slaughtered and their produce – animals which died of natural causes + exports + change in animal stock.

Intermediate Consumption: Value of animal feeds as input in the production of livestock and livestock products (such as broiler starter concentrate, breeder concentrate, ground cake, guinea corn etc.)

1.3 FORESTRY

Section A, Division 02 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Value and quantity of timbers of various types (firewood, charcoal, uncultivated materials gathered). Other forest products obtained using expenditure approach. Sawn-logs, and other wood products categories are obtained using the production method, whereby, the quantity of logs produced is multiplied by the price per cubic of log.

Intermediate consumption: Expenditure on seeds and sapling, fuel oils, lubricants, feed, hand tools and spare parts, payments for contract work and other services.

1.4 FISHING

Section A, Division 03 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Measured by multiplying quantity in kilogram by the average price to obtain the value of production.

Intermediate consumption: Intermediate consumption here is captured according to expenditure on fingerlings, nets, feeds and other operating expenses.

2. MINING AND QUARRYING

Section B, Division 05-09 of ISIC Rev 4.0

2.1 CRUDE PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS

Section B, Division 06 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Quantity of crude petroleum produced (barrels) and Natural gas in million cubic feet (mcf) multiplied by the average price in domestic currency (equivalent of the price in dollar during the account period).

Intermediate Consumption: Includes purchase of consultancy services, Transportation, Electricity Bills, Water bills, Cost of Fuel used, Minor Repairs and Maintenance, Medical expense to staff, License & Registration fees, Travelling allowance, Staff Uniform, Rents on machinery & buildings, Spare Parts etc.

2.2 COAL MINING

Section B, Division 05 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Quantity produced multiplied by the average price.

Intermediate Consumption: Cost of raw materials used; both imported and Local, purchase of consultancy services, transportation, electricity bills, water bills, cost of fuel used, minor repairs and maintenance, medical expense to staff, royalty, travelling allowance, special clothing use at work, rents on machinery & buildings, Spare Parts etc.

2.3 METAL ORES

Section B, Division 07 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Quantity produced multiplied by the average price

Intermediate Consumption: Cost of raw materials used; both imported and Local, purchase of consultancy services, transportation, electricity bills, water bills, cost of fuel used, minor repairs and maintenance, medical expense to staff, royalty, travelling allowance, special clothing used at work, rents on machinery & buildings, Spare Parts etc.

2.4 QUARRYING AND OTHER MINING

Section B, Division 08 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Quantity produced multiplied by the average price

Intermediate Consumption: Cost of raw materials used; both imported and local, purchase of consultancy services, transportation, electricity bills, water bills, cost of fuel used, minor repairs and maintenance, medical expense to staff, royalty, travelling allowance, special clothing used at work, rents on machinery & buildings, Spare Parts etc.

3. MANUFACTURING

Section C, Division 10-33 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross output = Revenue from sales of goods + Revenue from sales of goods bought for resale (trade margin) + Revenue from rendering services to other + Closing stock of finished goods - Opening stock of finished goods + Closing stock of work-in-progress - Opening stock of work-in-progress

Intermediate consumption = Purchases of raw materials and supplies + Purchases of goods bought for resale + Purchases of packaging materials + Fuels and lubricants + Electricity + Water and Sewerage + Repair and Maintenance + Freight charges and transport + Closing stock of raw materials and supplies - Opening stock of raw materials and supplies + Insurance premium + All other costs and expenses for goods and services

4. ELECTRICITY, GAS, STEAM AND AIR CONDITIONING SUPPLY

Section D, Division 35 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross Output: The value of output is the amount of gas and electricity paid for. Hence, value added is the output less intermediate consumption.

Intermediate Consumption = other cost of sales + Indirect expenses

5. WATER SUPPLY, SEWERAGE, WASTE MANAGEMENT AND REMEDIATION

Section E, Division 36 of ISIC Rev. 4

Gross output = Water revenue + Sewage revenue + New connections

Intermediate Consumption = other cost of sales + Indirect expenses

6. TRADE

Section G, Divisions 45 to 47 of ISIC Rev. 4.

Gross Output: This is equal to the trade margin, i.e. the difference between the revenue of goods sold and the value of the goods purchased for resale.

Intermediate Consumption: Goods and services needed to run the trading establishment, such as packaging materials, electricity, office supplies, and rentals.

7. CONSTRUCTION

Section F, Division 41 to 43 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross Output: Value of work done and other incomes.

Intermediate Consumption: This comprises cement, blocks, metals/iron bars, sand, stone, wood, gravel, other construction inputs, and cost of fuel used by generator, water bills and expenses on internet services/telephone/postage bills during the construction period.

8. ACCOMODATION AND FOOD SERVICES

Section I, Division 55 to 56 of ISIC Rev. 4.

Gross Output: Income generated from Accommodation, Catering, Restaurants, Beverage Service activities, Other income

Intermediate Consumption includes expenses incurred in running the businesses.

9. TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE

This industry broadly categorized under ISIC Rev. 4, Section H, division 49-53. The sector is divided into 6 sub-economic activities.

9.1 ROAD TRANSPORT

Section H, Division 49 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: The output of road transport is the revenue generated for the period under consideration.

Intermediate Consumption: Intermediate consumption consists of fuels and lubricants used

electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

9.2 RAIL TRANSPORT AND PIPELINES

Section H, Division 49 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Receipts from passengers, goods traffic and subventions from Federal Government. The Petroleum Pipeline Product income is from the transportation of the petroleum products and crude oil to designated depots and refineries in Nigeria.

Intermediate Consumption: This consists of the summation of all expenses incurred in the production process such as fuels and lubricants used, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

9.3 WATER TRANSPORT

Section H, Division 50 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Receipts from passengers and goods traffic.

Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

9.4 AIR TRANSPORT

Section H, Division 51 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Receipts from passengers and Cargoes (goods traffic).

Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals, Spare parts, Consultancy, Audit fees

9.5 TRANSPORT SERVICES

Section H, Division 52 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Receipts from services for storage and transportation activities.

Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used, transportation cost, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

9.6 POST AND COURIER SERVICES

Section H, Division 53 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Receipts from services rendered on number of mails and parcels handled.

Intermediate Consumption: Fuels and lubricants used, transportation cost, electricity bills, water bills, office supplies, and rentals.

10. INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION

Categorized under ISIC Rev. 4, Section J, Division 58-63, the sector is divided into 4 economic activities:

10.1 TELECOMMUNICATION AND INFORMATION SERVICES

Section J, division 61 to 63 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross Output: Revenue from telephone, telex, Facsimile, telegraph, and other income from satellite and internet services.

Intermediate consumption: Transit fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance and other expenses.

10.2 PUBLISHING

Section J, Division 58 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Revenue from publishing services.

Intermediate consumption: This includes details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs etc.

10.3 MOTION PICTURE AND SOUND RECORDING

Section J, Division 59 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross Output: Revenue generated/total sales from the number of movies and sound recordings produced including revenue generated from TV rights, royalties and fees.

Intermediate consumption: Detail on the cost structure of operating firms including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance, and other administrative expenses.

10.4 BROADCASTING

Section J, Division 60 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Public corporation data derived from Accountants General's reports, while private component relies on revenue generated from services rendered e.g. advertisement.

Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure of market participants which include transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance

11. ARTS ENTERTAINMENT AND RECREATION

Section R, division 90-93 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross Output: Revenue generated was estimated in two categories: one as a market output and the second as non-market output (public establishments)

Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure were obtained from the financial reports of firms.

12. FINANCE AND INSURANCE SERVICES

Section K, Division 64-66 of ISIC Rev 4, Finance and Insurance Services is divided into two (2) sectors.

12.1 FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Section K, Division 64 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Gross output for financial services are measured by Financial Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM).

Gross Output = Implicit service charges (FISIM) +Explicit service charges.

Intermediate Consumption: Details of the cost structure are extracted from the data supplied such as; Currency Issue Expenses, Administrative Expenses, Repairs and Maintenance, Consultancy Fees, Bank Charges, Audit fees, Directors related expenses

12.2. INSURANCE

Section K, Division 65 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output:

Output of life insurance: Output = Actual premiums earned + Plus Premium supplements -Benefits due -Minus Increases (plus decreases) in life insurance technical reserves

Output of non-life (General) insurance: Output = Actual premiums earned +Premium supplements - Adjusted claims incurred

Output of funded pension fund: Output = Actual pension contributions + Supplementary contributions -Benefits due +Plus Change in the actuarial reserves + Property income

Intermediate consumption: consists of the cost structure (operating expenses) from the annual reports of institutions.

13. REAL ESTATE

Section L, Division 68 of ISIC Rev 4

Gross Output: Sum of fees and commissions receivable for the services rendered.

Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational

expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

14. PROFESSIONAL SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL SERVICES

Section M, Division 69-75 of ISIC Rev 4.

Gross Output: Sum of revenues receivable for the services rendered.

Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

15. ADMINISTRATIVE AND SUPPORT SERVICES

Section N, Division 77-82 of ISIC RE 4.

Gross Output: Sum of fees and commissions receivable for the services rendered.

Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

16. PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

Section O, Division 48 of ISIC Rev. 4

Gross output Basic = Intermediate consumption (Less commodity sales and fees) +Compensation of employees+ Consumption of fixed capital +Other taxes less subsidies on production.

17. EDUCATION

Section P, division 85 of ISIC Rev. 4.

Gross Output: Consists of government production, which is a non-market service offered without charge or at a price not economically significant, and private production, offered at the market price.

Government Production (non-market service):

Gross output Basic=+Intermediate consumption (Less commodity sales and fees) +Compensation of employees + Consumption of fixed capital +Other taxes less subsidies on production.

Private Production (market service):

Gross output Basic=Total output -Intermediate consumption + other taxes less subsidies on production.

Intermediate consumption: Details of cost structure including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

18. HUMAN HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES

Section Q, Division 86-88 of ISIC Rev. 4.

Gross Output: Consists of government production, which is a non-market service offered without charge or at a price not economically significant, and private production, offered at the market price.

Government production (non-market service):

Gross output Basic = Intermediate consumption (Less commodity sales and fees) +Compensation of employees+ Consumption of fixed capital + Other taxes less subsidies on production.

Private production (market service):

Gross output Basic = Total output -Intermediate consumption+ other taxes less subsidies on production.

Intermediate consumption: Details of the cost structure of operators including transportation fees, operational expenditure, minor repairs and maintenance etc.

19. OTHER SERVICE ACTIVITIES

Section S Division 94 to 96 of ISIC Rev.4.

Gross Output: Income generated from the various services rendered.
