This Education Statistics is published by the Directorate of Statistics, Ministry of Economic Development, Akwa Ibom State. This is the maiden Edition since the declaration of Free and Compulsory Education in 2007 from Primary to Secondary schools levels in the State by the education loving Governor of Akwa Ibom State, His Excellency Chief (Dr) Godswill Obot Akpabio (CON).

The publication focuses mainly on the State owned educational institutions and covers 2007/2008 – 2012/2013 School Years. The information provided is on the enrolment trend and number of teachers in the three levels of education in the state.

The Education Statistics is divided into 3 sections namely: Primary schools statistics, Post-primary schools statistics and Tertiary Institutions statistics.

Data in this publication were collected from the State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB); State Secondary Education Board (SSEB); State Technical Schools Board; State Agency for Adult and Non- Formal Education; Akwa Ibom State College of Education, Afaha Nsit; Akwa Ibom State Polytechnic, Ikot Osurua; and Akwa Ibom State University, Ikot Akpaden .

It is hoped that this publication will be useful to the Government, Planners, Researchers and other users of Official Statistics for effective planning and formulation of policies on education in Akwa Ibom State. However, constructive criticism and suggestions for the improvement of subsequent editions will be appreciated.

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SECTION ONE

PRIMARY SCHOOL STATISTICS

This section focuses on the number of Public Primary Schools, pupils enrolment trend, number of teachers by sex and qualification in the thirty one Local Government Areas of the State from 2007/2008 – 2012/2013. Data on number of Adult and Non-Formal Education Centres and Learners enrolment as at the time of this publication were available from 2007/2008 – 2011/2012.

Table 1.1 shows that the number of Public Primary Schools increased from 1138 in 2007/2008 to 1,154 in 2012/2013 school year. In the same vein, the enrolment of Pupils rose from 761,422 in 2007/2008 to 1,079,199 in 2012/2013 school year making 42 percent increase in pupils' enrolment within the period (Table 1.3).

On the other hand, the number of teachers in public Primary Schools decreased considerably from 15,223 in 2007/2008 to 14,525 in 2012/2013. Perhaps, the reason for this decrease was as the result of the number of teachers who retired from service after the completion of their years in service.

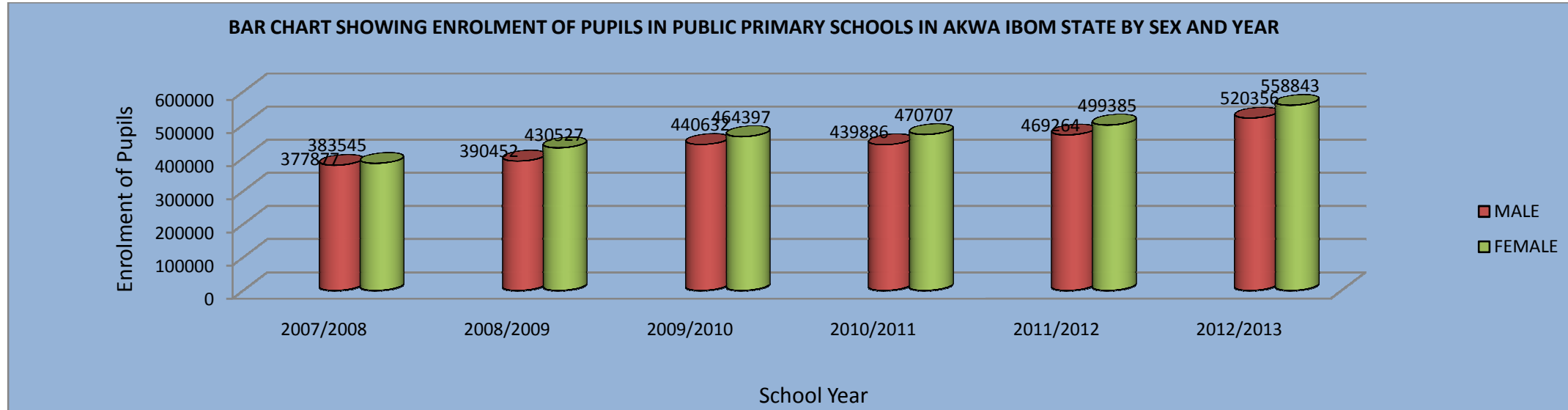

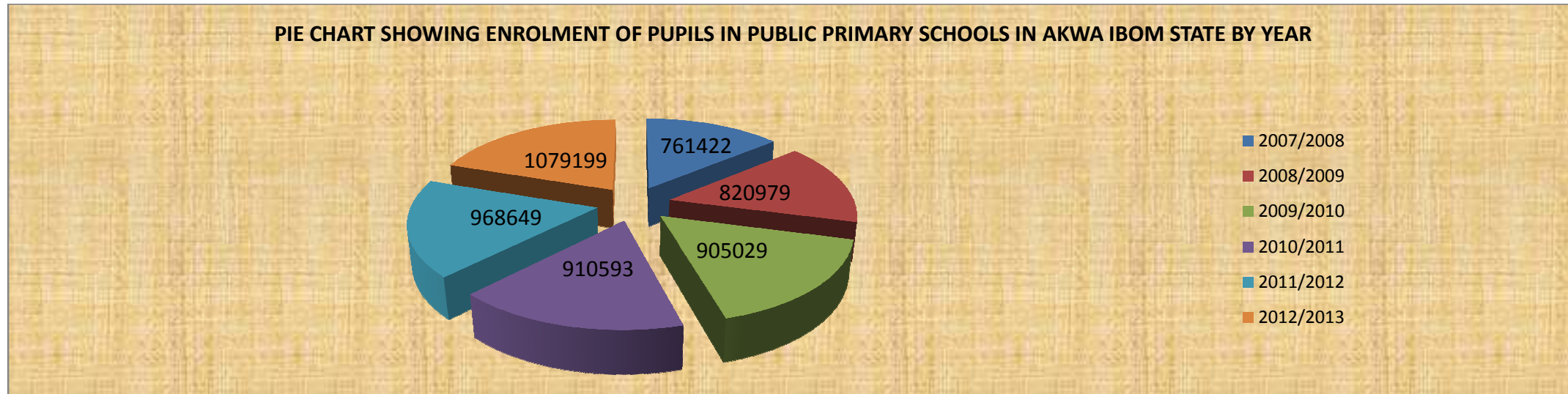

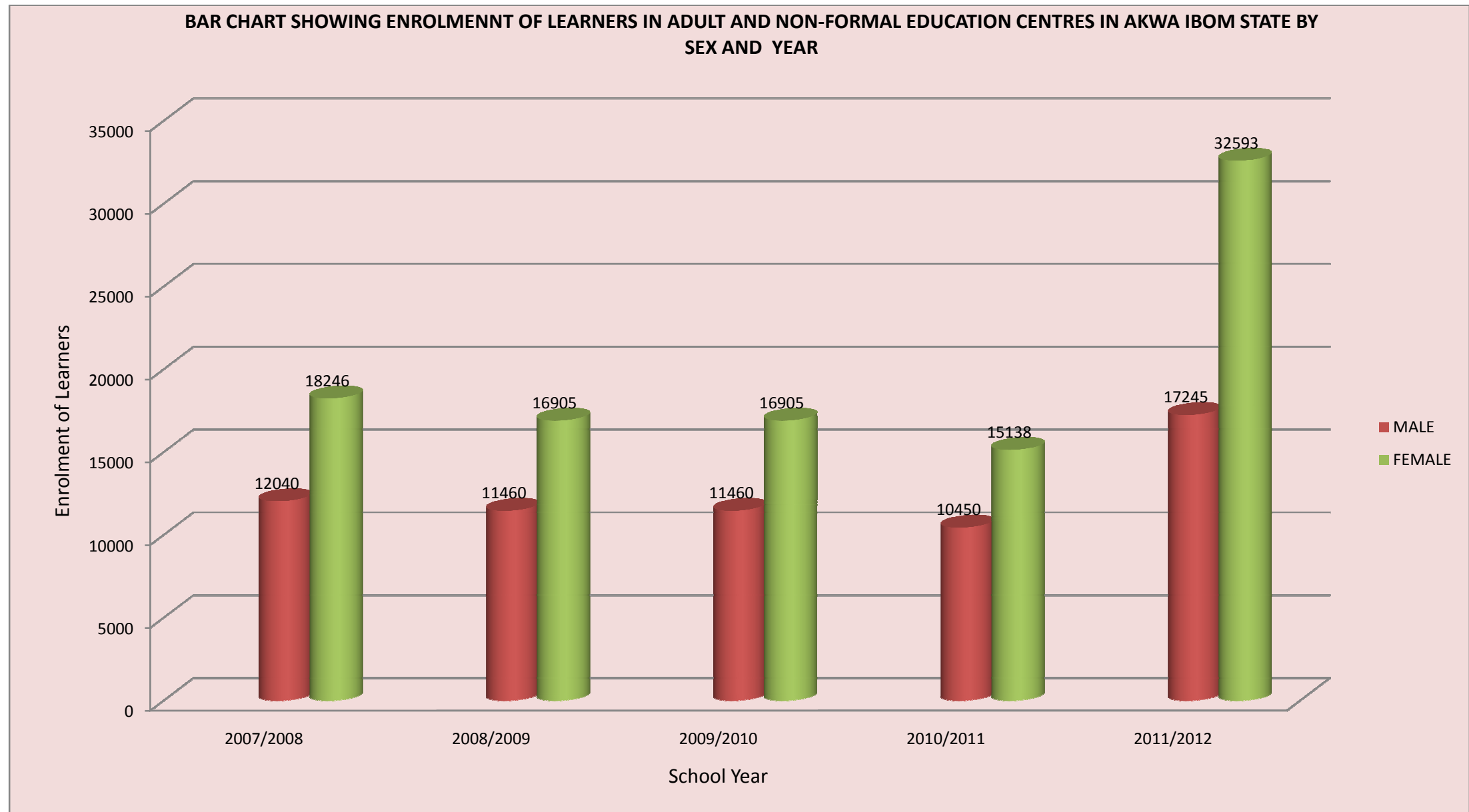

SECTION TWO

POST-PRIMARY SCHOOL STATISTICS

This section presents data on State owned Public Secondary Schools and Vocational Training/Technical Colleges in Akwa Ibom State. The number of Public Secondary Schools was 241 in 2007/2008 school year. Following the handing over of schools to the original owners by the State Government, the number reduced to 227 in subsequent years and rose again to 233 in 2012/2013 school year. There were six Vocational Training/Technical Colleges in the State between 2007/2008 and 2012/2013 academic years with two of the schools in each senatorial district. As a result of free and compulsory education in the State, enrolment in Public Secondary Schools rose from 150,692 in 2007/2008 to 341,809 in 2012/2013 showing an increase of 127 per cent (Table 2.3) while Students' enrolment in Vocational Training/Technical Colleges rose from 10481 in 2007/2008 to 17,667 in 2012/2013 showing an increase of 69 per cent (Table 2.6) within the period of this present administration.

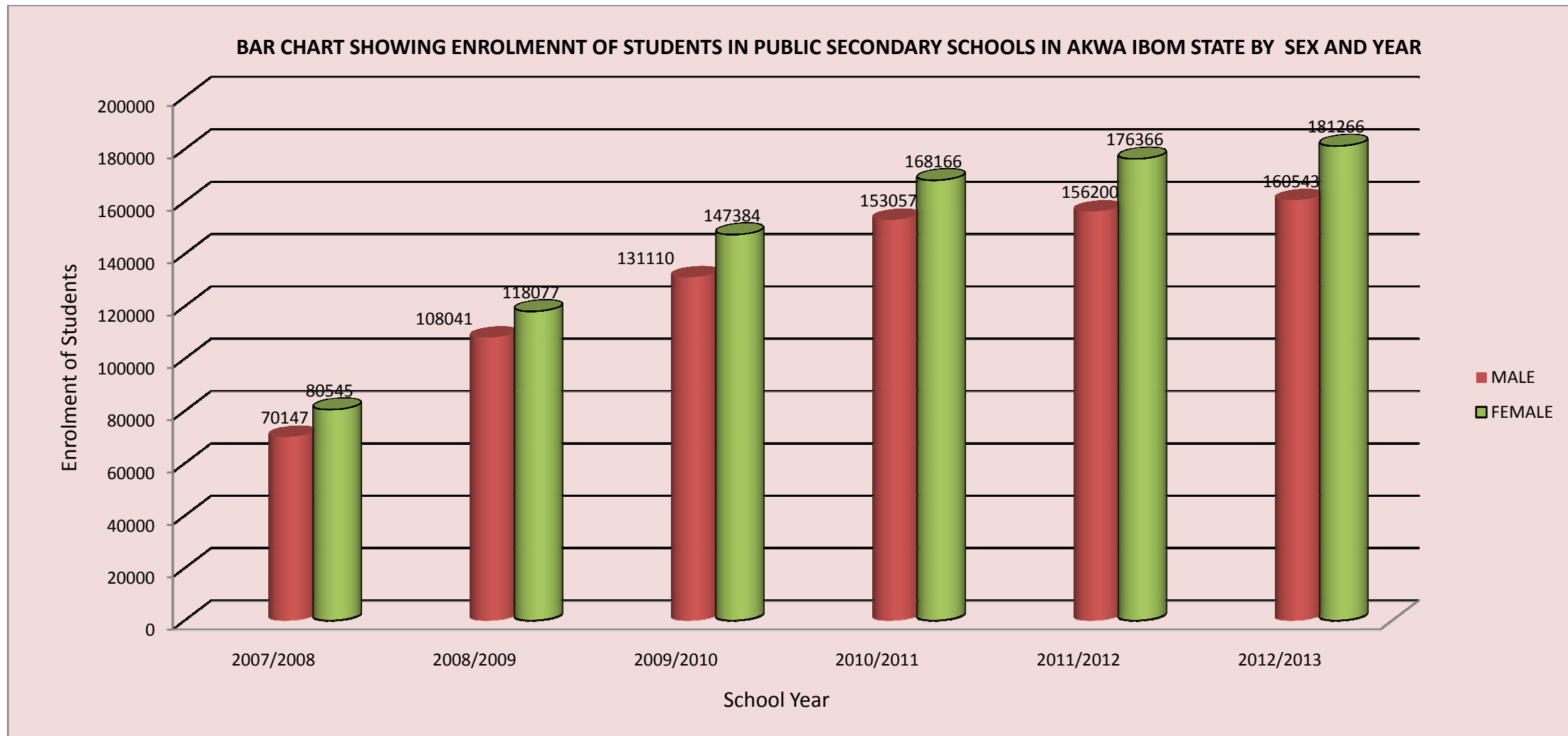

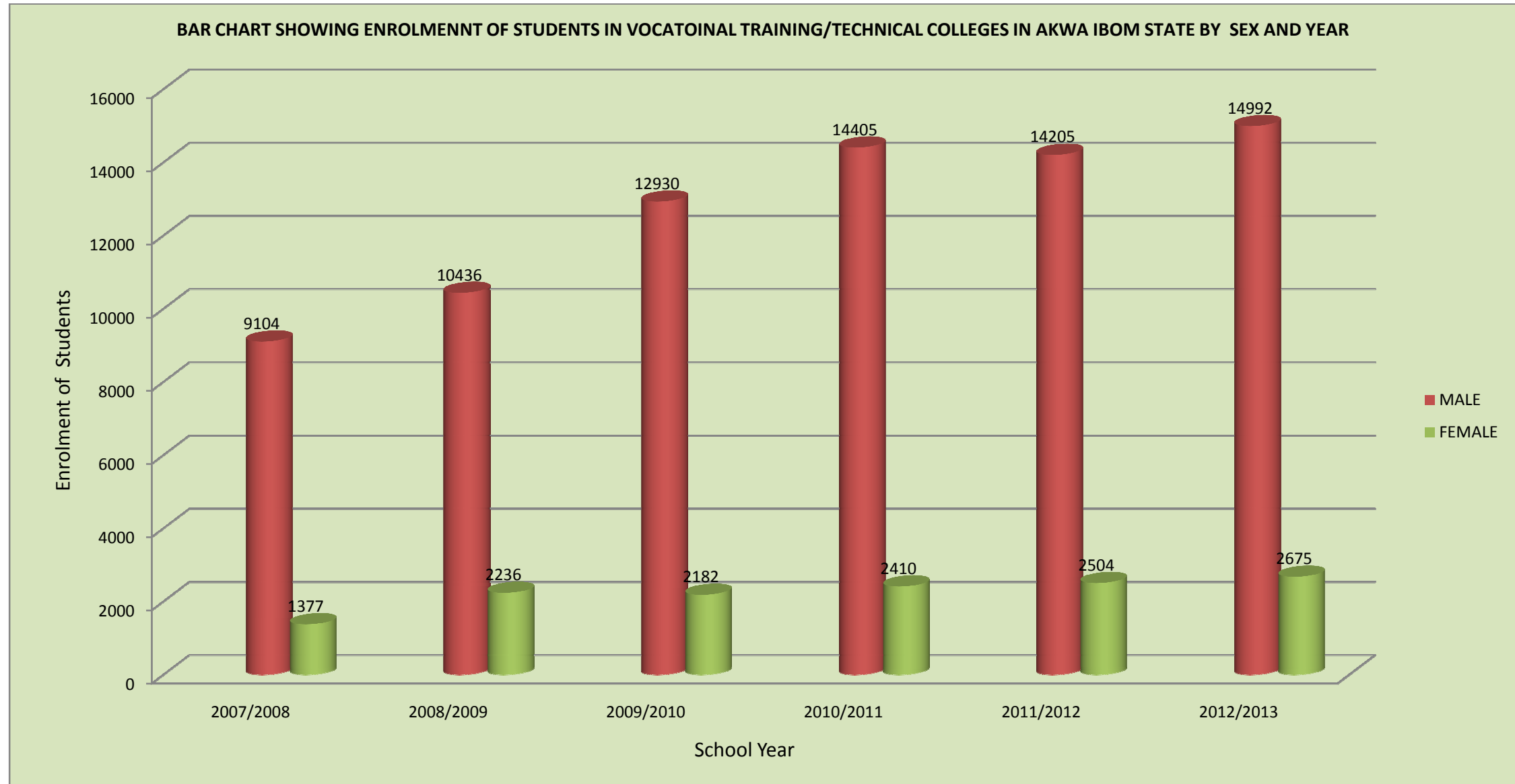

SECTION THREE

TERTIARY INSTITUTION STATISTICS

Data presented in this section include enrolment of students in Akwa Ibom State Polytechnic, Ikot Osurua; Akwa Ibom State College of Education, Afaha Nsit and Akwa Ibom State University, Ikot Akpaden.

Table 3.2 shows that students' enrolment figure in Akwa Ibom State Polytechnic, Ikot Osurua rose from 1637 in 2008/2009 academic year to 2476 in 2011/2012 while in Akwa Ibom State College of Education, Afaha Nsit it decreased from 5455 in 2007/2008 to 2786 in 2012/2013 Academic year (Table 3.4).

In the seven Faculties of the Akwa Ibom State University, Ikot Akpaden enrolment rose from 292 in 2010/2011 Academic year to 2247 in 2012/2013 Academic year.

Information on staff strength (academic and non- academic staff) in these institutions was not available at the time of this publication.

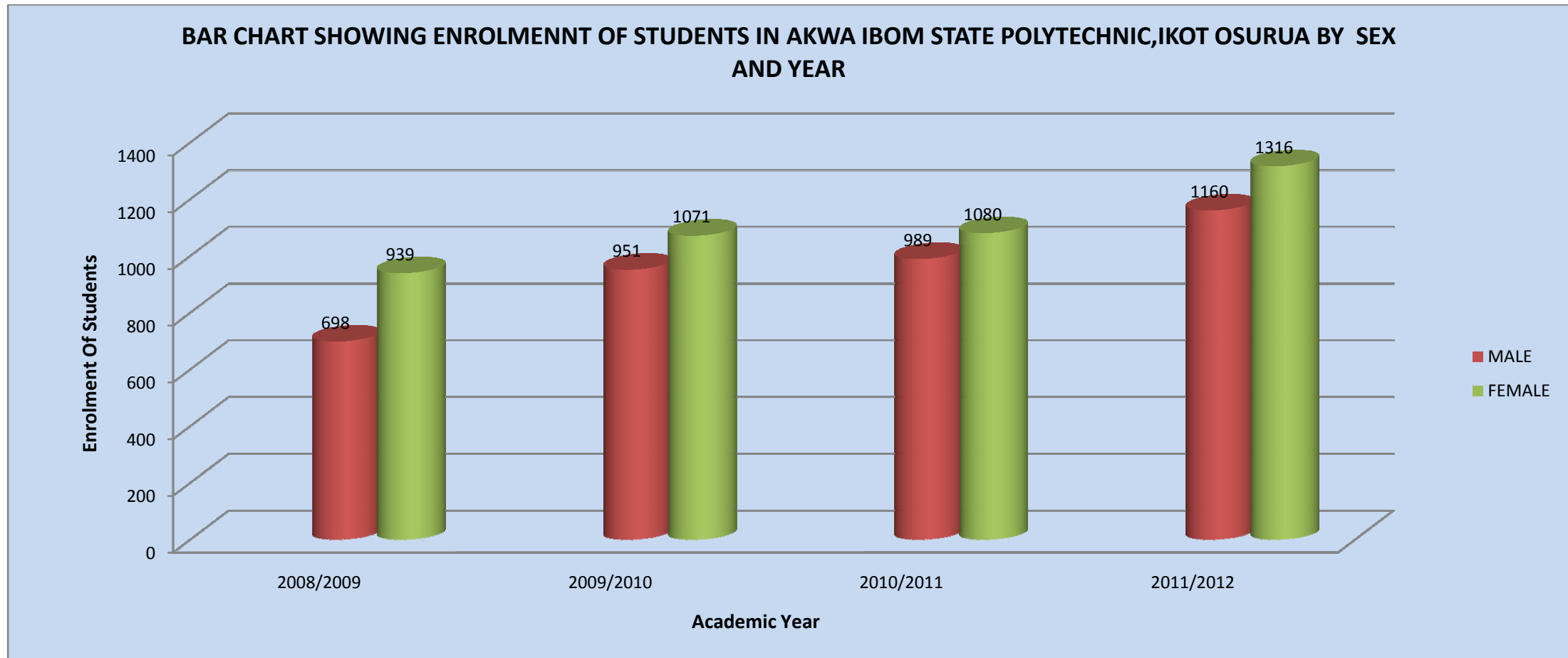

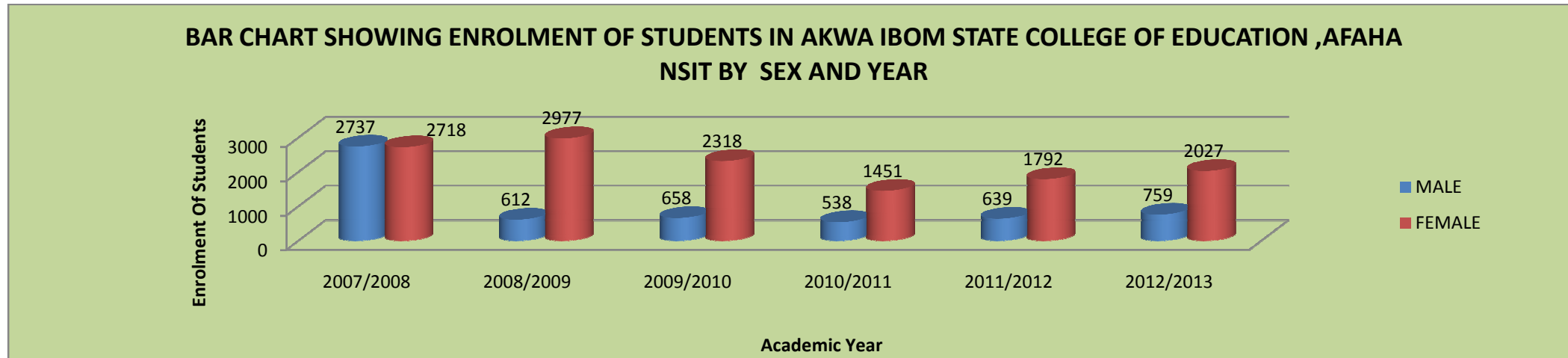

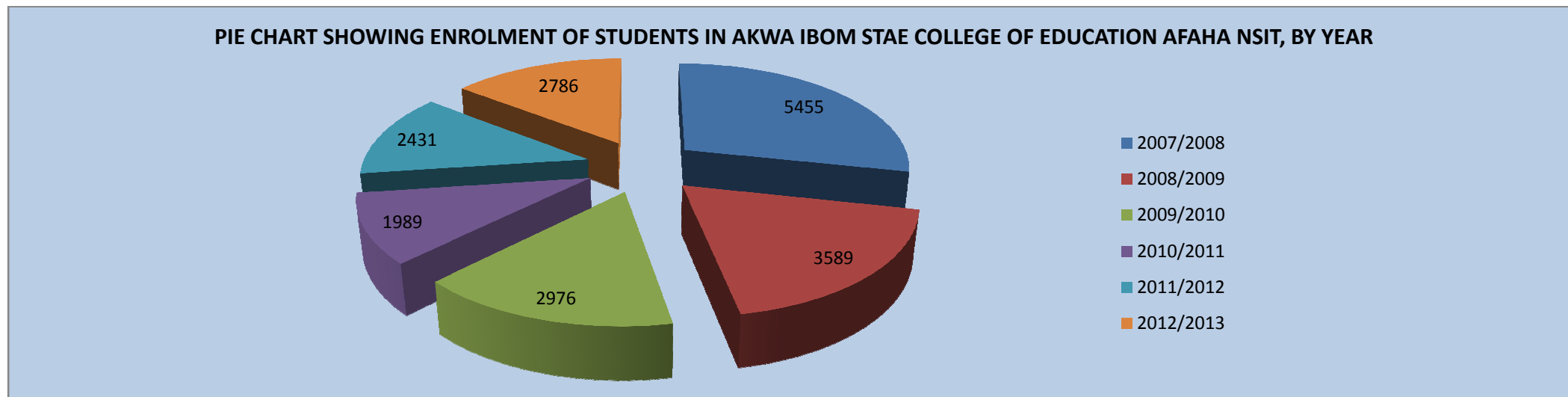
