DEFINITION OF A HOUSEHOLD

In this survey, a HOUSEHOLD will be defined as a group of people who USUALLY SLEEP in the same dwelling and take their MEALS TOGETHER, and either have been part of the household for at least 6 of the 12 months preceding the interview or are currently members and are expected to still be household members 6 months after the interview.

1. Examples of households are:

A household consisting of a man and his wife/wives and children, father/mother, nephew and other relatives.

A household consisting of a single person

A household consisting of a couple or several couples with or without children.

2. INCLUDE as household members:

Persons that are identified as head but did not spend 6 of the past 12 months in the household

New-borns, persons that have just married or moved into the household, e.g. adopted children, new live in worker

Students and seasonal workers who did not spend 6 of the past 12 months in the household and did NOT live as part of another household

2. EXCLUDE as household members:

Guests, even if relatives, who are staying for a few days, weeks, or months (under 6), normally live in another household and are expected to return to a different household after a while

Family members that maybe stay in the same dwelling or compound, but do not normally eat with the household

Persons who have been hospitalized and did not spend 6 of the past 12 months in the household
