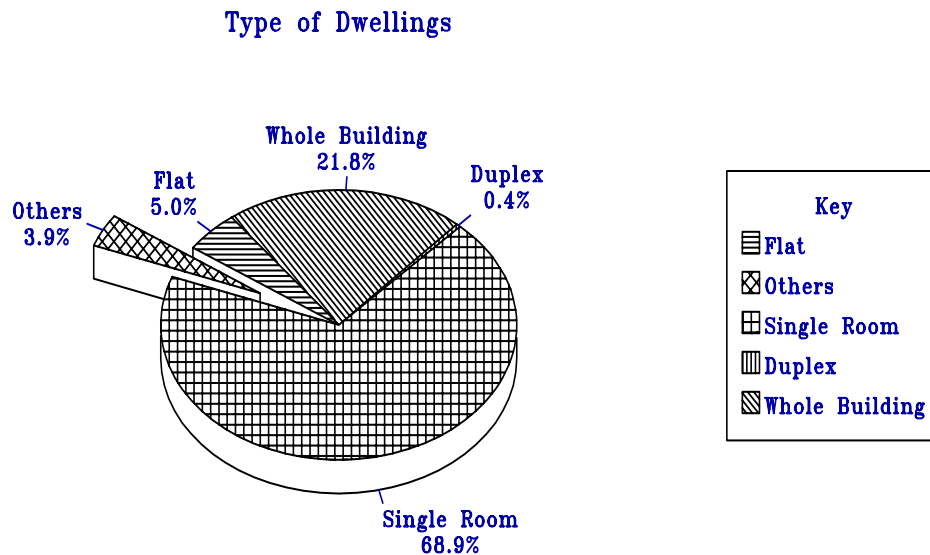


## 3.0 FINDINGS IN SOCIO-DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS

***THE SURVEY FOUND THAT 68.8 PERCENT OF ALL HOUSEHOLDS LIVED IN ‘SINGLE ROOM DWELLING’***

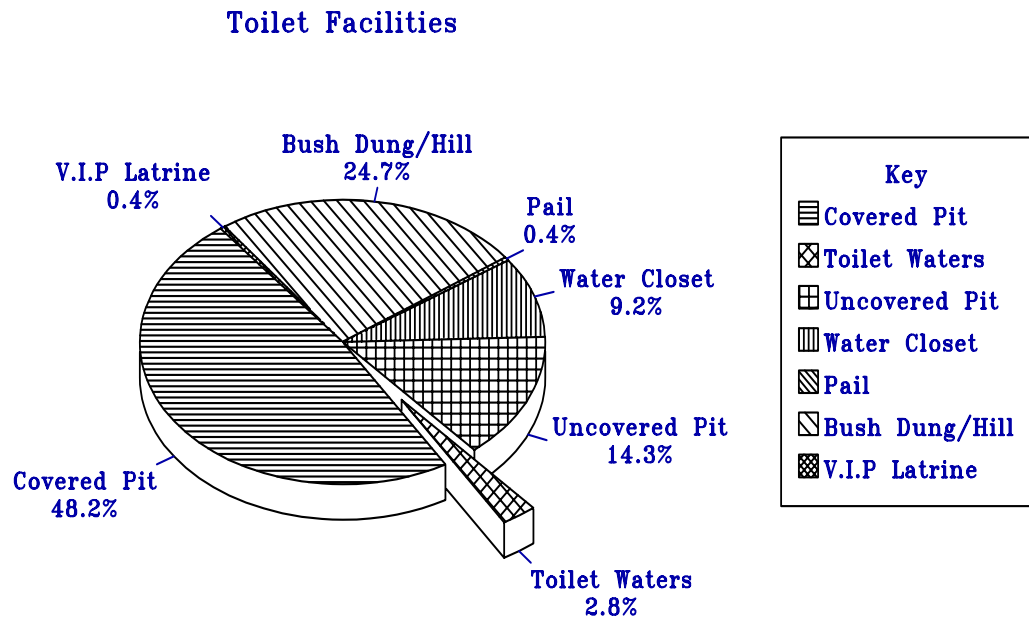
PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF HOUSEHOLDS BY TYPE OF DWELLING (NATIONAL)

### PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF HOUSEHOLDS BY TOILET FACILITY (NATIONAL)



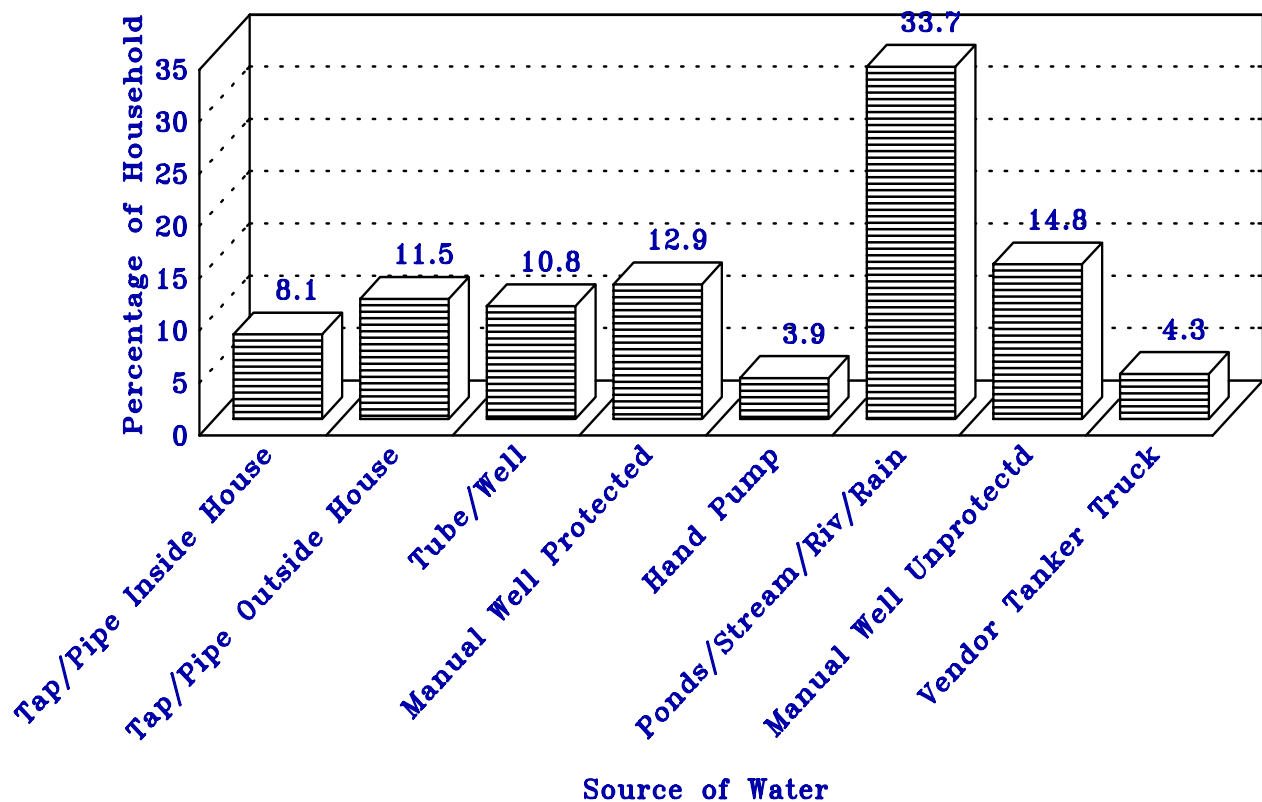

### 3.3 SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER

***THE SURVEY INDICATED THAT THE MOST COMMON SOURCE – 33.7 PERCENT - OF DRINKING WATER IN HOUSEHOLDS WAS POND/RIVER/STREAM/RAIN WATER***

PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF HOUSEHOLDS BY MAJOR SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER (NATIONAL)



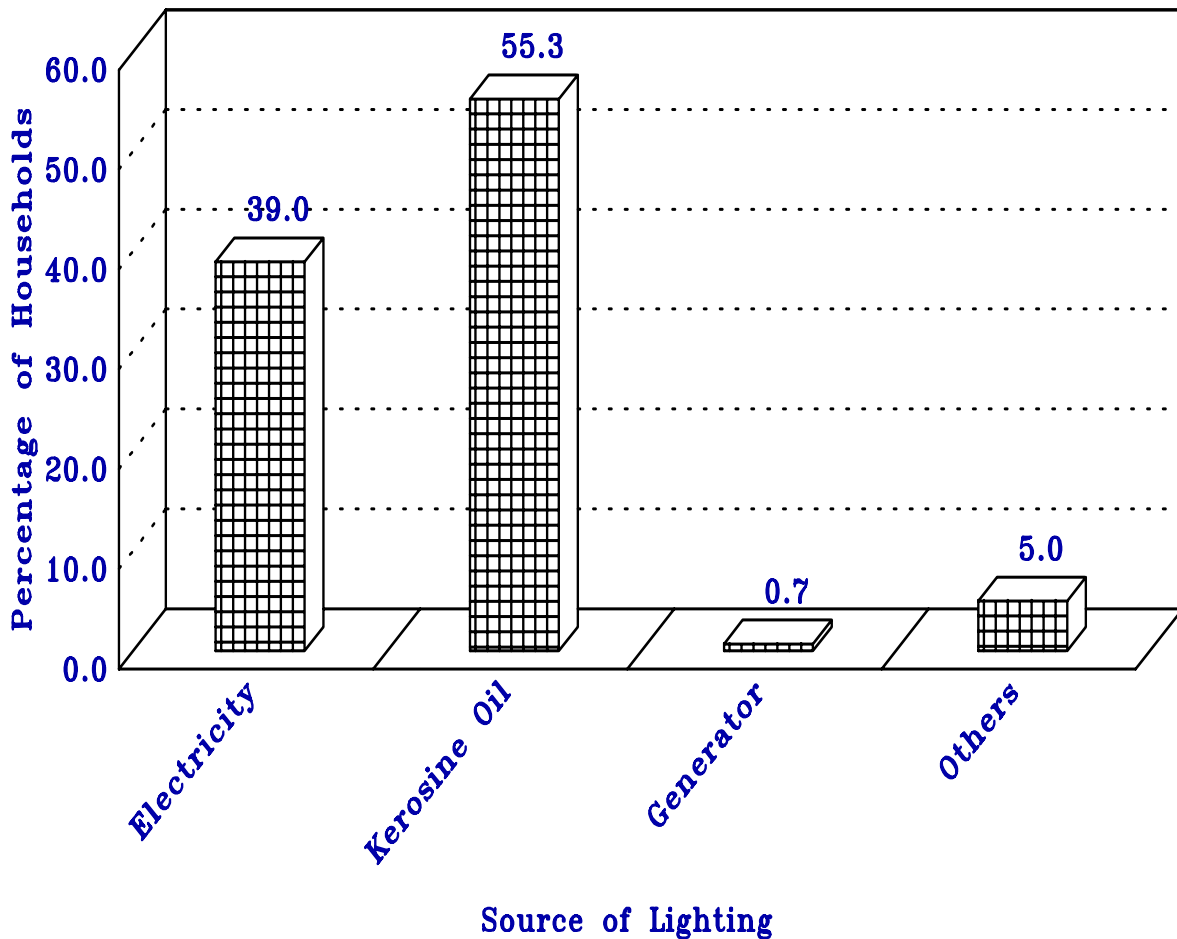

***Kerosine oil constituted the most common source – 55.3 percent - of lighting***

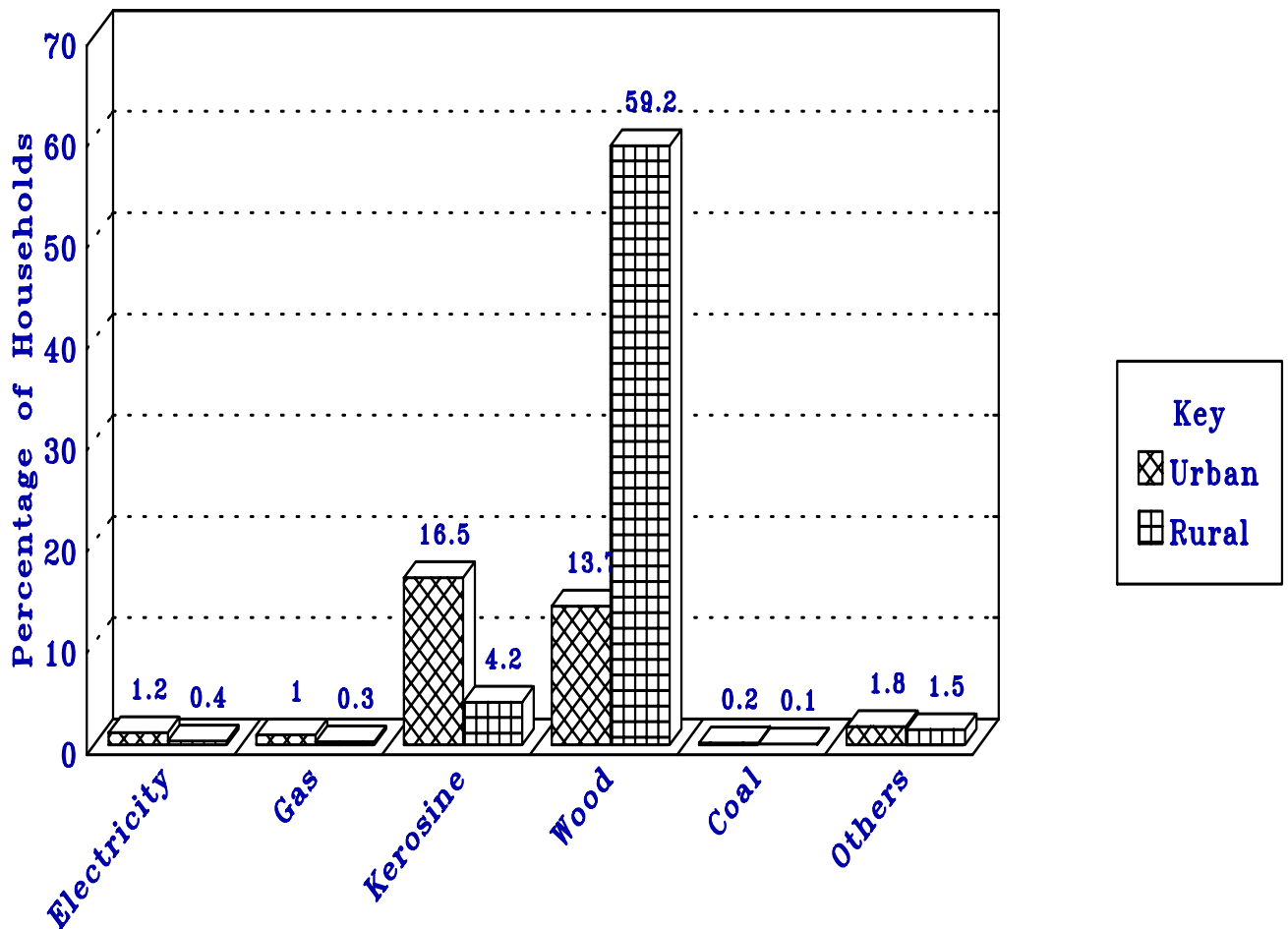
PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF HOUSEHOLDS BY MAJOR SOURCE OF LIGHTING (NATIONAL)
